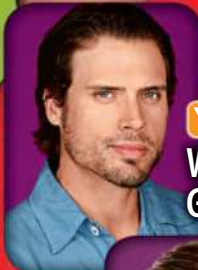

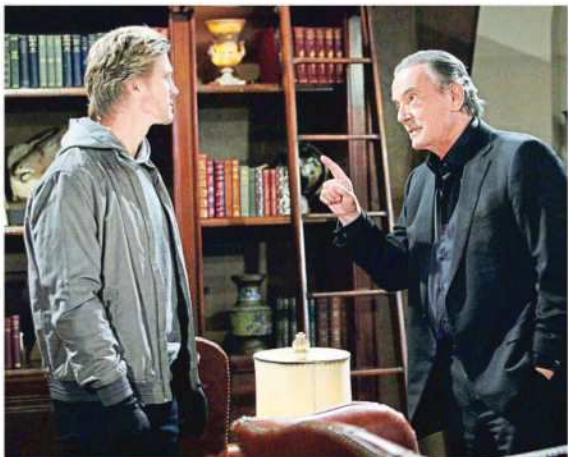

"In the Younger categories, it's a lot smaller [pool]. Then you dive into Supporting, and the competition definitely shifts," she shares.

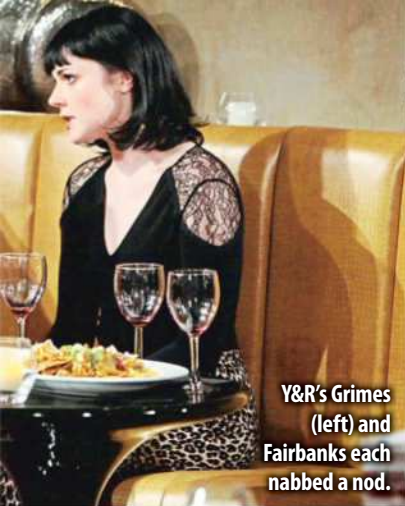

about it. The character in particular is great, and the storyline is fantastic. I'm very excited to dive into a show that is so long-standing and one that I know very well."

Brewer, who is now a blonde, was welcomed with open arms

on the set of the Australian drama. "They're all incredible — from cast and crew to the production side of things," she said. "Everyone has been just wonderful. It's a dream to walk into."

Working on Australia's Palm Beach, where HOME AND AWAY tapes, is another dream, even if it will be wintertime Down Under. Brewer revealed that living in the Bondi area has always been on her bucket list, "so I'm really glad that I can come here and work on top of it."

Once her six-month run is done, Brewer plans to return to Los Angeles.

"My house is there, my boyfriend is there, my dog is there, my whole life is there," she explained.

"In terms of long-term acting work, I've always just made a promise to myself that I'll continue to work as an actress for

as long as possible. So far, so good, and hopefully I can keep carrying on."

And even if those future plans do not include a B&B visit with her Uncle Eric, or a return to fight once more for ex Liam, Brewer looks back on her time at the soap fondly. "The same way as NEIGHBOURS — I'm very grateful for these shows," she shared. "They bring you in, they look after you, and you learn very fast. but the timing of the patriarch's return certainly puts him right in the middle of a lot of family drama, including daughter Lily's opposition to Hilary having a baby with Devon!

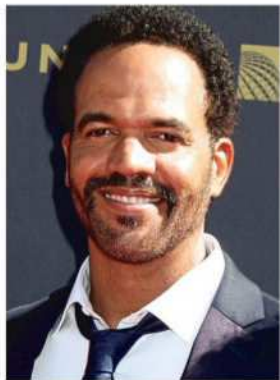

Jack thought the toast to sobriety was absolutely lovely. Sadly, though, he'd already drained his wine glass, so he couldn't join in.

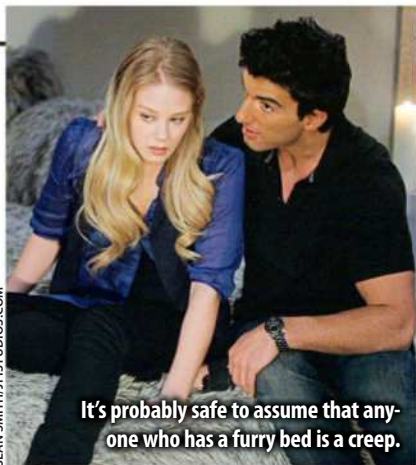

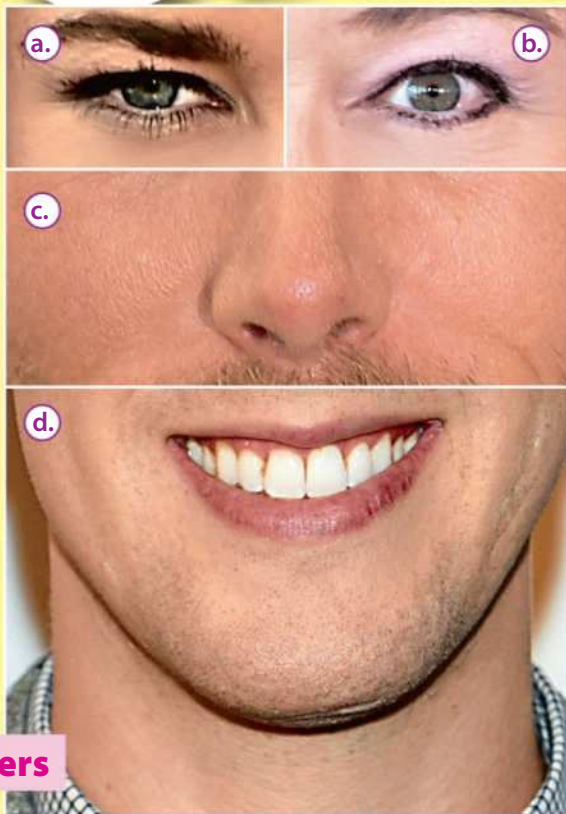

JOURNEY *from* DARKNESS

Lexie Stevenson (Mattie) hopes to enlighten girls and women by sharing her harrowing battle with endometriosis

When *THE YOUNG & THE RESTLESS*' Lexie Stevenson (Mattie) hit puberty in 2012, she began to experience the agonizing abdominal cramps that come along with endometriosis — a disease where the tissue inside the uterus begins to grow outside that organ. “I didn’t really know what was happening,” she confesses. “I was in middle school and just assumed that other girls were going through the same thing. When the pain became bad, I would usually take the day off and go home. But each year, the pain would increase.

“Over time, it became so bad that I ended up in the ER,” she adds, “because my parents didn’t know what else to do.”

Despite the visits to the hospital, Stevenson says that the doctors were baffled by

her condition. Worse, they began to doubt her. “They wondered if stress was causing it, and more than once, they asked my parents if I was getting enough attention at home,” she shares. “That made my mom upset!”

It actually wasn’t until 2016 when Stevenson finally was diagnosed. “One night, I was at my boyfriend’s house, and I fell to the floor screaming,” recounts Stevenson. “It was unlike any pain that I’ve ever experienced. What happens with endometriosis is that it can cause liquid-like cysts on your ovaries. I had two on each ovary, and they both ruptured at the same time. When I went to the ER, they did an internal ultra-

sound — I had only had external ultrasounds — and they discovered that I had growths that looked like endometriosis.”

Fearing cancer, the doctors operated on Stevenson and discovered that a golf-ball-sized piece of her intestine had actually been pinched off by the endometriosis. “When I ended up in the ER, my boyfriend’s parents had given me Advil or Tylenol, but I was still screaming in pain. The doctor gave me five milligrams of oxycodone, but I was still in pain. Even when they gave me morphine, I was still screaming,” she recalls quietly. “I should have been passed out, given *(continues)* ▶

my size at that point, but I was in so much pain that it didn't subside. Because I think the pain that women endure with endometriosis is constantly underestimated, I want to give people an idea just how painful it is!"

Spreading The Word

Indeed, Stevenson has taken to social media to raise awareness by blogging about her experiences. "I realized that so many women might be experiencing painful cramps and not realize that it's endometriosis," she says, "so I really want to do something. If I could help one person who reads [my blog], and they could get information

from it, I think that would be cool!"

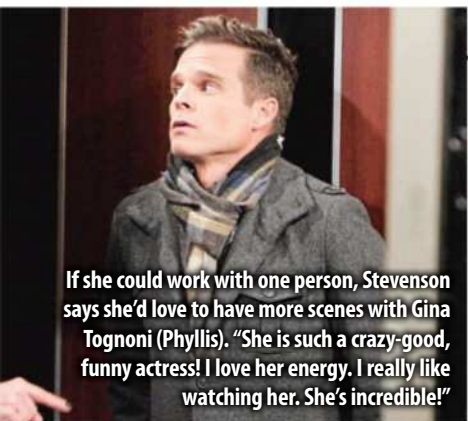
While many women resort to prescription drugs to deal with the pain, Stevenson says that she's had some success through her diet. "There is no cure for endometriosis," she warns. "But I've cut gluten out of my diet. I've heard that for 70 to 80 percent of women who go gluten-free, it reduces the pain. I've also limited my soy intake. Red meat and dairy don't bother me, but I've heard that they can bother a lot of women. I've read that an anti-inflammatory diet really helps — eliminating breads, pastas, a lot of salt. But it's really trial and error!"

SHARE TIME

Because of her experience of being dismissed and misdiagnosed for so long, Stevenson says that she wants to emphasize how real endometriosis is. "If somebody says they're in pain, they probably are!" she suggests. "I wish my case would have been taken more seriously from the beginning, because it would have saved me a lot of anguish. I know I'm not the only one!" This year, Stevenson and her mother participated in a march for endometriosis awareness in Portland, ME, and the actress plans to do more activities to let people know about the disease. A Little Romance

Endometriosis is an ongoing illness for those who suffer from it, but Stevenson refused to let it stop her from pursuing her dream of acting — scoring big time when she landed on Y&R as Lily and Cane's SORAS'd daughter. "I relate a lot to Mattie," she says. "She's had a lot on her plate, always wanting to be the absolute best she can be but also dealing with her family issues, which can make it hard to focus."

In the short time that she's played the character, Mattie has loved and lost her beau, Reed, dealt with her dad's infidelity, her parents' near divorce and now their

reconciliation — which has meant the new addition to the family of baby brother Sam. "Mattie has forgiven her father, but she hasn't forgotten," she says, noting that her alter ego's ambivalence could make for an interesting story down the line.

So would Mattie and Reed, adds Stevenson. "I think it would be fun to re-explore that story, to see where it would go if Reed and Mattie got back together. That would be fun!"

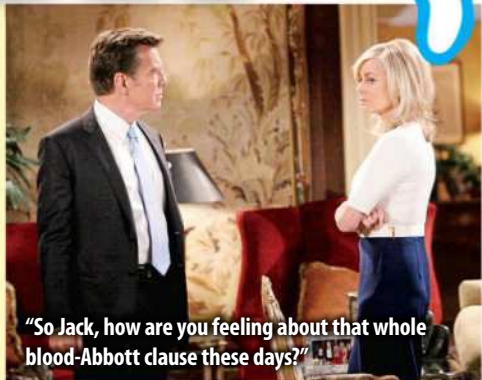

The scene with Eric turned out well, but I *was* nervous!’”
