LETTER FROM THE EDITOR SEBASTIAN MICHAELS

I'm really quite lucky. Because while we all get to enjoy seeing the artwork celebrated here each month, I've gotten to know many of these artists. I've seen them grow. And I've heard from many over the years as they worked through whatever it was they needed to work through to end up here.

Because it's not always a comfortable ride.

Sure, many come to the artistic life out of simple joy, out of the pure delight in learning to create something amazing.

But others come to art for a reprieve from suffering, or for healing, or for catharsis.

More times than I can recall, I've received messages and emails from students thanking me for providing this world of "AWAKE," where they can make friends, get inspired, and share their art. Too often (from the sounds of it) they have precious little support from friends or family. And too often there is something painful in their day-to-day lives they come here to rest from awhile.

The camaraderie of the group we've formed is powerful. The support the artists give one another is incredible. And I'm sure I only see a small part of it all.

There's something extraordinary in the creative act — in tapping into your imagination and stepping outside of your daily problems, worries, and concerns — and that state of wonder and release frequently fuels the most powerful artwork you find here each month.

Not that you would ever know it.

But that impassioned reach for *meaning* and *freedom* and *importance* inspires more of the artwork here than you might think.

And often, it's an impassioned endeavor precisely because "real life" can be so damned hard.

We have artists here who are suffering from chronic illness, from depression, from crushing ailments of all kinds.

We have artists who are battling cancer. (And artists who have beat it back.)

We have artists who have lost loved ones — friends, parents, even children.

We have artists grieving over the loss of dear pets that felt like family to them and might as well have been.

We have artists who have lost their jobs, artists trapped in awful relationships, artists struggling with addictions, artists dealing with families that are falling apart.

Yet through all of this ... they CREATE.

They fight on.

They find something beautiful and important, a voice of their own, a voice defiant of suffering and loss... And from that place, in spite of everything life throws at them, they create ART.

They create. And they leave their mark on this world.

And that both inspires and humbles me.
