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
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
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

She's spent more than a decade putting Wayne's footballing career before herself and their family, but now Coleen Rooney may have the final say in their potential move to Washington

he downside of being a footballer's wife is that, despite the wealth and privileges, your own needs and those of your family come secondary to their career.

This has been Coleen Rooney's reality ever since she and husband Wayne Rooney both shot to fame at the tender age of 16, when Wayne became England's new footballing whizz-kid.

He officially retired from international football duties last August. Then, just a fortnight ago, he said his goodbyes to his Everton teammates, with a move to Washington's DC United on his radar.

As we went to press, the $\pounds 12.5$ million deal – which was 'agreed in principle' – took an unexpected twist when Everton's boss, Sam Allardyce, was sacked.

Bad blood between the pair is believed to be the reason Wayne, 32, was leaving his childhood club – so now he could stick around for another 12 months (the length left on his contract), with his wife the driving force behind him staying.

'Despite the money and the chance of a fresh start, Col isn't happy about the potential move to the States,' says a source. 'She would have been much happier if it was somewhere like LA, where she could have set up a business of her own and had a glam lifestyle.

'But in Washington, she feels like she'll be surrounded by politicians and bores.'

In an interview with us earlier this month, Coleen, 32, said she coped with their four children by having a 'real support network' of family and friends around them, but she would lose all of that if they moved to Washington.

Plus, we're told the 'dynamic in their marriage has shifted' since Wayne was caught drink-driving in the company of party girl Laura Simpson last September, when Coleen was four months pregnant with their fourth son, Cass.

Coleen admitted she considered ending their nine-year marriage, and it's been reported that Wayne pulled out all the stops to win her over.

'Coleen has more control since Wayne's embarrassing scandal, which nearly cost him his family and career. She no longer feels the need to put his needs before her own,' adds our source.

'When she decided to give their marriage another go, she told Wayne, in no uncertain terms, that it was her turn to have a chance of career happiness.


'She wants to establish herself before the kids [Kai, eight, Klay, four, Kit, two, and three-month-old Cass] grow up and fly the nest. They're also building their dream home, and Col wants to enjoy that.'

her own TV show *Coleen's Real Women*, and had a Littlewoods fashion range.

Col was rumoured to be taking part in the new series of *Strictly Come Dancing* but, earlier this month, she denied this.

Our source continues, 'She may not be doing *Strictly*, but Col has been eyeing up other TV opportunities and projects.

'She admires Louise Redknapp and saw how she took back control of her life and moved on from Jamie. She relates to her and thinks they're similar. They both gave up a part of themselves for their man.

'She's not saying she's going to move on from Wayne, but she wants her chance to be put first in the relationship for once.'

'NOT EVERYTHING IS FINE'

Coleen is also said to be annoyed their 10th wedding anniversary celebrations on June 12 may be scuppered, as Wayne is wanted as a TV pundit for the World Cup in Russia, which starts on June 14.

'Col is a smart girl – she knows she could have a great career,' says our source. 'She's sacrificed a lot for Wayne and bringing up their family. Now she feels her needs should come first, but Wayne has just defaulted to type. She feels like he's forgetting all the promises he made to her when he agreed to work on their marriage.

'All this Washington talk may come to nothing, but she has already laid down the law and told Wayne that if he wants this, then until they go, her needs come first.'

Wayne's scandal last year seemed to be the final straw for Col, since she'd already put up with his past infidelities.

Yet, while she has confirmed she 'wants their marriage to work', she also admitted 'not everything is fine and forgotten about'.

Coleen credits Wayne with being a wonderful father to their boys, and they've been trying to keep things as normal as possible for the sake of their children.

'She's OK at the moment, as nothing is confirmed on the Washington front, so she's putting on a united front with him,' says the source. 'But she's still stinging from the drink-driving debacle and – now she's had the baby and is getting back into shape, she feels it's HER time to shine.'

hursday, May 24, marks three years since Mark Wright and Michelle Keegan became man and wife at a lavish £1 million wedding ceremony in Suffolk.

But, instead of spending romantic quality time together to celebrate their anniversary, the couple will be on different continents – as Mark attends his brother's stag do in the States.

Josh Wright, 28, will be tying the knot with his fiancé, Hollie Kane, in Majorca in early June. Josh, his best man, Mark, and a gang of their mates are jetting out to America for a week of celebrations until May 29, meaning Mark won't be with Michelle on their anniversary.

'Mark actually helped choose those dates and plan the stag do,' a source spills to us. 'He knows it's not ideal for him and Michelle, but he wants the best send-off for his brother, and these were the only dates they could agree on.

'Josh is a semi-pro footballer [he's just left Southend United FC], so they had to work it around his commitments.

'The footballing season only finished in mid-May, and then the wedding is at the beginning of June, so the weeks in between were the best time to do it. They're going to have three days in LA, then three wild nights in Vegas.

'Obviously, Michelle is a bit upset, but Mark has promised to spoil her when he returns to the UK for a week after the stag – plus, her birthday is on June 3, so that has softened the blow.'

Mark, 31, now based in LA, was back in the UK last week as he geared up to report on the royal wedding on behalf of his US TV show, *Extra*. He was pictured enjoying a night out for Josh's home stag do in Essex at the beginning of the week.

But, oddly, he accepted

a gig as a DJ on the same night that Michelle, 30, attended the Bafta TV Awards last Sunday, meaning she took her close friend, Katie Fearnehough, to the ceremony as her plus one instead.

MARK EXTENDS HIS TIME IN LA

On top of that, our source confirms to us that Mark has '100 per cent' signed another 12-month deal to work on *Extra*, after months of speculation.

'Mark signed last week,' the source tells us. 'He's really loving it in LA – he's in the sun, mixing with A-listers and making a name for himself globally. It's a long way from where he started on *TOWIE*.

'When he first got the role as *Extra* host last September, it was for 12 months, but it's been going so well that he couldn't turn down the opportunity to extend it.

'Even though it's putting distance between him and Michelle, who wants to stay in the UK for yet another year, they

know they have to make the most of it now, before they start a family.'

Last week, during an interview on ITV chat show *Lorraine*, the hostess urged Mark to 'use [your connections] and get it sorted' for actress Michelle to land a Hollywood role, to which he replied, 'I'm trying!'

Yet, while Michelle is open to a US acting role, she has ruled out a permanent move, confessing she's a 'homebird' who would miss her tight-knit friends and family in Manchester and Essex.

Our source explains, 'Although Michelle has been looking for short-term acting roles out there, she doesn't have any intention of living there full-time.'

During the same interview with Lorraine Kelly, Mark said that he and Michelle – who spent eight months of 2017 apart, due to her filming commitments with BBC drama *Our Girl* – made their marriage work by 'using the plane like a bus'.

'We are back and forward [between UK and Los Angeles] all the time,' he said. 'I come back for the weekend to see her. We make sure it's three weeks maximum that we don't see each other for.

'[The distance] actually keeps it fresh, and, while we're young and both conquering our dreams, I am out there, trying to make something happen, she's around the world acting and we are still so in love and so happy, so it's perfect.'

However, Michelle has been pictured looking super-slender recently, and last week we told you how the pressure of Mark's increased workload had apparently led her to losing weight.

'In the past three weeks, she's the slimmest she's ever been,' a source told us. 'It looks as if she's lost another 3lb.

'While she's absolutely thrilled that Mark has landed even more work in the States and is doing so well, the pressure of her trying to work out how that all fits in to their marriage is definitely affecting her.'

hen Scarlett Moffatt was sent to a Swiss bootcamp and forced to exercise for six hours a day on a 700-calorie diet two years ago, she was left in tears and traumatised by the experience.

Yet she's been so unhappy by recent pictures of herself that she's vowed to go back on a strict diet and exercise mission, as she's 'sick of looking like a couch potato'.

Scarlett is adamant she won't let her *Gogglebox* body return and is set for a bikini bootcamp,' a source tells us. 'She feels she needs to do this for both her mental and physical health. She hates the way she looks and

feels at the moment. 'She's going abroad for the two-week bootcamp. She just needs to clear her head and have a body that's fit and fighting.

The I'm A Celeb ... winner-turned-TV presenter was criticised for her choice of outfit for the Baftas earlier this month, which was mocked for resembling a tent'. She has also been accused of photoshopping her Instagram snaps to make herself look slimmer, with one fan telling her, 'You could have chosen something more flattering rather than this shapeless tunic, no matter what [your] size. You should embrace your shape and not blatantly lie on Instagram.'

Scarlett, 27, publicly

laughed off the hurtful comments, telling her 662,000 Twitter followers, 'My style is either pure street or mam picking her kids up straight after a business meeting."

But we're told that the negative feedback stung Scarlett deep especially as it follows a difficult few months for her.

She's back with Lee Wilkinson, who she accused of being a 'cheating psychopath' after he admitted to texting his ex.

She was wrongly accused of being involved with her good friend and colleague, Ant McPartlin, during his split from his wife Lisa Armstrong. And her 2016 fitness DVD was then exposed as a 'scam', forcing Scarlett to admit her 3st weightloss had largely been due to the gruelling Swiss bootcamp, rather than the exercises she portrayed in the best-selling SuperSlim Me.

On the plus side, her TV career is at an all-time high – she even reported on Prince Harry and Meghan Markle's royal wedding for the BBC over the weekend.

Scarlett has confided in friends that things have been so up and down that she's stuck in a food and booze rut,' explains the source.

'The whole thing with Lee has also made her feel insecure, so she believes if she shapes up, she will feel more confident within the relationship.'

While Scarlett says the bootcamp made her miserable, her new diet and exercise bootcamp will be more realistic.

In 2016, Scarlett told us she had cried when, at 11st 4lb, her GP informed her she was 'obese' – although she has since admitted she found maintaining her size-8 figure a struggle.

Our source reveals that Katie and Shane have been talking openly about adding to their respective broods.

'For Katie, the fact Shane wants a baby too is perfect timing,' reveals our insider. 'She is worried time is running out for her to get pregnant.

'She and Shane have even had romantic conversations about how many kids they want to have together, and what they would call them.'

Last week, we reported Katie had been spending time with Shane and talking to him on the phone. Days later, her famous pink Range Rover was pictured in the drive of Shane's Brighton pad.

And, while Katie is keen on fast-tracking her romance with Shane – who has, allegedly, convinced her that he's not just a 'typical footballer', despite his cheating past – estranged hubby Kieran, 31, is not best pleased.

'Katie is using every opportunity to get over to Shane's house and spend time with him, while Kieran is often at home with the kids. She then has to go home and try to live a relatively "normal" life with Kieran for the kids' sake,' our source says.


She added, 'I don't feel any different now, apart from the fact I go to bed at eight every night.'

On the same day, she had a near run-in with her ex-hubby, French businessman Jean-Bernard Fernandez-Versini, who was at the same bar. Cheryl was pictured heading up some stairs while JB was in the background. He was later spotted chatting at the bar with singer Tallia Storm. During the trip, a tired Cheryl admitted she was exhausted. 'I've already had one nap... trust us, I am planning on squeezing in another,' she wrote on her Instagram story.

said the pair had 'struggled'. His frank admission came just weeks after Cheryl denied rumours that there was trouble in paradise for the couple.

And it seems their rocky patch may have taken its toll on Cheryl's physique.

'Cheryl feels she's lost too much weight recently, and it stems back to when her and Liam's relationship was under pressure,' a source explains.

'She's about 7lb lighter than she was at the start of the year – a weight loss Cheryl did not want.

'She's always found herself losing weight if she's anxious or worried about something. There's no doubt that trying to make her relationship work, coupled with the pressures of being a mum and also trying to relaunch her career, have taken their toll.'

Instead of being by his girlfriend's side at Cannes, 24-year-old Liam was in America. He's spent a large chunk of the past year touring to promote his solo album, due out in September, plus his steamy Fifty Shades duet, *For You*, with Rita Ora, 27.

Last week, in another damning comment, Liam admitted on a US radio show that he was in 'no rush' to marry Cheryl.

'We might do it in the long term, but it's not a big deal,' he shrugged.

AN EMOTIONAL RETURN

Cannes may have brought back difficult memories of Cheryl's ex, second husband Jean-Bernard. The pair first made their relationship public at the film festival in May 2014 and married two months later, before their 14-second divorce in October 2016.

And Cheryl, who came within arm's reach of JB last week as she returned to his home patch, has been left 'feeling emotional'. e became a household name as one-fifth of chart-topping boyband One Direction. But last week, Liam Payne opened up about the nerves he suffered from before he embarked on his solo career.

The Bedroom Floor singer explained, 'When the band broke up, I struggled with the idea of becoming famous again. The last time it nearly killed me, frankly.'

Starring on *The X Factor* in 2010, Liam was 14 when he first auditioned in front of Cheryl. Now, he says he has learned to deal with the pressures of being in the public eye.

'I laugh it off and remember it will become a story one day,' he said.

Our insider adds, 'Cannes brought back memories of her and JB when they were at the start of their relationship and had a really close bond. She feels vulnerable when she revisits those memories – so that reflects on her figure and her overall look.'

Cheryl has previously admitted to slimming down when anxious. Bravely describing some difficult years when she was growing up, she explained, 'I'd been clinically depressed and dangerously underweight. I was having terrible panic attacks and suffered from anxiety. As a result, my appetite went.'

> The pain of her divorce from JB also saw Cheryl shed the pounds. Citing his 'unreasonable behaviour', lawyers acting on behalf of the ex-Girls Aloud singer claimed JB's actions caused 'stress and weight loss' to the former *X Factor* judge.

CHERYL'S COMEBACK

However, with Cheryl relaunching her TV career next year on Simon Cowell's new BBC show, *The Greatest Dancer*, our source says the singer is determined look her best.




Joshua Sasse -2013-17





This week marks the first anniversary of the Manchester Arena bombing on May 22, 2017. We speak to Lucy Jarvis, 18, who almost lost her life in Britain's deadliest terrorist incident since 7/7...

his time last year, Lucy Jarvis was like any other teenager – studying for her A-levels and thinking of taking a gap year before going to university.

But, on May 22, she went to an Ariana Grande concert at the Manchester Arena with her friend, Amelia, and was caught up in a petrifying terrorist attack – an experience she is still recovering from.

'We'd had a great night together watching Ariana,' says Lucy, from Wigan. 'She's an amazing live performer. We were sat on the end of the row, so we left before most people.'

While Amelia was on the phone to her mum, who was waiting to pick the girls up outside, Lucy guided them out of the venue.

But, as they walked into the foyer, they were just yards away from suicide bomber Salman Abedi, 22, as he detonated his device. As the bomb exploded, they were blown backwards.

'It's blurry, but I remember little things like being on the floor and feeling really hot,' explains Lucy. 'When I looked down, I saw there were holes and rips in my jeans and my

'Then I heard Amelia shouting my name,' Lucy continues. 'I turned and saw her running back into the Arena, so I got up and tried to follow. But I couldn't see much, as my vision was flashing in and out and my ears were ringing from the adrenaline.'

Despite suffering injuries that, doctors later said, should have meant she wasn't able to stand, let alone walk, Lucy managed to climb 15 steps to a platform.

[']That's when I realised I was hurt,' she says. 'I looked down and touched my legs, and my hands came away red. I kept asking Amelia if I was going to die.'

As the bomb had gone off, 30 pieces of shrapnel had torn through her body and she'd suffered serious injuries to her legs and internal organs. One piece of shrapnel ripped through her abdomen and damaged a kidney, her bladder and bowel, while another severed the main artery of her right leg.

'Two guys, John [Clarkson] and Paul [Worsley], stayed with me for two hours before an ambulance arrived,' says Lucy. 'They worked at the Arena and were trying to bandage up my injuries. I asked them to take my trainers off, as my feet were really swollen but, if they'd done that, I would have bled to death. They saved my life.'

As Lucy struggled to stay

conscious, a stranger took her phone and called her parents, Dave and Kath.

'It was every parent's worst nightmare,' says Dave, 54. 'Someone said, "Your daughter, Lucy, has been really badly hurt. Something has happened, we think it's a bomb." Then the phone went dead.'

It took three hours for them to track Lucy down to Salford Royal Hospital, where medics then spent the next 14 hours life-changing physical injuries, but she also started suffering from night terrors while in hospital. 'I'd wake up nearly every night at the same time in this hot sweat.' she recalls.

this hot sweat,' she recalls. Her physical recovery has been long and hard. Since her first surgeries, she's had a further eight operations, lasting 50 hours in total.

Two months after the attack, Lucy was allowed home, but

she still receives daily physio.

I'm on crutches still,' she says.

'And there's a lot of swelling

battling to save her.

'She wasn't expected to survive the night,' says her dad. 'It was very touch-and-go. Lucy was unconscious for 10 days, and she spent three-and-a-half weeks in intensive care.'

'At first, they didn't know if they would have to amputate my leg,' adds Lucy. 'A few pieces of shrapnel penetrated through my bladder and kidneys. I also have wounds on my arms and a lot of nerve damage in my legs.'

In the days that followed, it was revealed that the suicide bomber had, horrifyingly, killed 22 people in the attack.

'I kept hearing stuff on the news, but Mum and Dad would turn the TV off,' says Lucy. 'I knew deep down that it was a terrorist attack.'

Not only did Lucy experience

Dave adds, 'John and Paul were absolute heroes to go into an active terrorist attack to save lives. We're firm friends and have even been invited to one of their weddings.'

The family will spend May 22 together in Manchester.

'We're invited to the cathedral service in the afternoon,' explains Lucy. 'There will be a choir and a two-minute silence.' A year on, she is undaunted.

'I feel like I'm the luckiest unlucky person. Although

unlucky person. Although it was awful, I'm still alive,' she says. 'I'm not going to let this experience change the way I live.'

'Ny son helps me film emotional scenes'

Emmerdale's Emma Atkins, 43, who plays Charity Dingle, talks about her darkest storyline yet, and how her son makes her smile outside of work

ince crashing into the Dales 18 years ago as Charity Dingle, actress Emma Atkins' troubled character has endured everything from a prison sentence for insurance fraud to being framed for the murder of her first husband, Chris Tate.

More recently, fans have watched Charity admit she fell pregnant after being raped and held prisoner by bent policeman, DI Mark Bails (played by Rocky Marshall), when she was 14. She then revealed her baby had, tragically, died.

In an upcoming flashback episode, to be aired on May 29, viewers will be able to see what really happened to Charity and her son.

Here, Emma, 43, who welcomed her own son, Albert, in 2015 with her long-term partner, Tom, tells us that she used her experiences as a mum in the harrowing scenes...



HOW DID YOU FEEL ABOUT FILMING THE FLASHBACK EPISODE?

It was incredibly challenging and the hardest thing I've ever done on the show, but I loved every second of it. You have to go to difficult places and draw upon your personal experiences of loss, which isn't particularly pleasant, but it's part of the journey. Charity's history really helped. She's made a right mess of bringing up most of her children, and I've used those memories to remind her what a rubbish mum she is at times. I get a lot of inspiration from music, which sounds naff, but it's very evocative and emotive.

WHAT WAS IT LIKE FILMING THE SCENES, THEN GOING **HOME TO YOUR OWN SON?**

Harrowing! At home, you have to switch off because your responsibilities come railroading in. My house is very hectic. When I think about Albert during a scene, it immediately brings emotion. I can't even bear to think

about him passing away, like Charity's son. It's also weird to trick your body into crying all day. It starts thinking, 'We're having a nervous breakdown,' and you make yourself ill!

WHAT'S ALBERT LIKE NOW?

He's funny, lovely and very caring. He says, 'Have you had a good day, Mummy?' I explain that I've been crying at work, and he's like, 'You have to cry on your job?' It confuses him, but he's brilliant. In the newsagent, we saw a magazine showing me and Charley [Webb, 30, who plays her onscreen daughter, Debbie] on the cover. He knows her really well, and said, 'Mummy, that's you and Charley on the paper. How do you explain that to a three-year-old? I just bought him a lollipop and we walked out - end of!

DID YOU KNOW CHARITY'S PAST WAS THIS DARK?

I knew she'd been a prostitute,



Meghan Markle was a thoroughly modern royal bride, taking her place among the Windsors as the new Duchess of Sussex

t midday on a sunny Saturday afternoon, American actress Meghan Markle married Prince Harry in St. George's Chapel, at Windsor Castle.

But their big day was far from your usual royal wedding, with 36-year-old Meghan shaking up tradition as she joined the royal establishment.

Starkly different to Prince William and Kate Middleton's grand state affair in 2011, with 1,900 people invited, Meghan's marriage to 33-year-old Harry was more humble, with only 600 guests in the chapel.

But, unlike Kate and Wills, Meghan and Harry had only close friends and family at the event, with state leaders left off the guest list.

Instead, 1,200 'inspirational members of the public', who have demonstrated strong leadership in the community, were invited to join the couple on the big day.

Harry ditched the traditional royal formality of not having a best man, choosing brother William to stand by his side for his wedding.

AN ALL-AMERICAN GIRL

Suits actress Meghan was determined not to ignore her American roots.

A gospel choir belted out the Ben E King classic *Stand By Me* during the service. While the song is a popular wedding tune, it first gained popularity during the civil rights movement – used for solidarity among people of colour in America.

Harry and Meghan walked out to another gospel track – Etta James's *Amen/This Little Light Of Mine*. The non-traditional song choice undercut the usual pomp and ceremony and signalled that

Self-professed feminist Meghan changed her vows for the special day, omitting the traditional 'to honour and obey' line as she wedded Harry – with the outspoken star also thought to be the first royal bride to be making a speech at her reception.

And a besotted Harry, who emotionally told his bride he'd 'missed her' as she walked up the aisle, will differ from both William and Prince Charles by wearing a wedding ring on his ring finger.

As Meghan is welcomed into The Firm as Duchess of Sussex, it seems this all-American girl is well suited to the role of a very modern member of one of the world's oldest families.

'In addition, she may have used individual lashes on the outer corners to open up the eyes, and she loves to layer on her mascara for volume.'

eghan Markle was every inch the royalto-be as she walked down the aisle, resplendent in her gorgeous white gown, alongside her soon-to-be father-in-law, Prince Charles.

You look amazing,' breathed Harry as he saw his bride in her finery, before whispering, 'Thank you, Papa.'

Kensington Palace revealed last Friday that Harry's dad would be giving Meghan away, after a week of speculation about whether her own father would be able to attend.

'The Prince of Wales is pleased to be able to welcome Ms Markle to the royal family in this way,' the statement read.

Many people assumed that Meghan's mum, Doria Ragland, would do the honours. Instead, a clearly emotional Doria, 61, watched from a prime position as Charles gave Meghan away.

Doria flew into Heathrow

Airport last Wednesday, sharing tea with Charles and wife Camilla, 70, in the days preceding the wedding.

Doria, who has reportedly quit her job as a social worker in Los Angeles amid rumours she is to move to London. shares a close relationship with her daughter – whom she affectionately calls 'flower'.

Speaking about her mother in 2017, Meghan said, 'We have so much fun together, and yet I'll still find so much solace in her support. That duality co-exists the same way it would in a best friend.'

FAMILY COMPLICATIONS

In the run-up to the big day, the excitement was somewhat clouded by a series of controversies surrounding the Markle family.

Meghan's father, Thomas Markle, 73, was initially set to walk the Suits actress down the aisle in St George's

Chapel, Windsor, last Saturday. Thomas, a former Hollywood lighting director, was then photographed in his town of

Rosarito, Mexico – swotting up on British culture, being measured for a suit and staring at online stories of Meghan and Harry's relationship in an internet café.

Days later, it emerged that the photos had been 'set up' after he was pictured meeting with a renowned US showbiz photographer. Thomas was rumoured to have accepted a fee payment for the staged photos which he agreed to do after he was unhappy with previous pap shots of him buying beer.

Dad Thomas

couldn't be at Meghan's side

Thomas later said that he thought the pictures were 'stupid and hammy', and that he

had decided not to attend the wedding, so as not to embarrass Meghan or the royal family.

But, in another twist, it was then reported that Thomas had suffered a heart attack, and was having three stents fitted - tubing inserted to keep the arteries open. This would mean that he couldn't be in the UK for the wedding.

Thomas then pulled out of attending the wedding. His U-turn was so last-minute that his name was still listed on the official Order Of Service for the big day.

Watching the ceremony, he told celebrity news website TMZ, 'My baby looks

beautiful and she looks very happy. I wish I was there, and I wish them all my love and happiness.' Kimberlev Bond

When her boyfriend woke up with memory loss following a serious accident, Rebecca Doig, 29, from Dennistoun in Scotland, did all she could to help him put his life back together

hen Rebecca Doig signed up for Tinder, she only did it for a bit of a laugh. But, when she saw 28-year-old William Webster pop up on her screen, she immediately clicked on his profile and swiped right.

'He had a lovely smile and looked like he could be good fun,' says Rebecca. 'I was so excited when he asked me out for a drink.'

After arranging to meet up near where she lived, they instantly hit it off.

Before long, they were spending four nights a week together and planning weekends away. They were nearly a year into their relationship when William asked Rebecca to move in with him.

In August last year, when Rebecca was at work as a receptionist, she saw she'd had a few missed calls from William's sister, Suzie. She quickly called back, only to be told that William was in hospital.

Horrifyingly, he'd been hit by a bus that had skidded into him on his way to work. Due to debris on the road, William had lost control of the car, and was unconscious at the scene. All his bones had been broken, and he'd been airlifted to hospital.

Grabbing her jacket and handbag, Rebecca raced over to Queen Elizabeth University Hospital, Glasgow, to find William's parents and sister in the waiting room. By this point, he'd already had a couple of operations, and the family were waiting to hear more.

The doctor then told them that, if William did make it through the night, there was a high chance he'd be severely brain-damaged. They were then told they could see William if they wanted, although he was covered in bandages and looked lifeless.

'Seeing him like that was the worst thing ever,' says Rebecca. 'It really upset me, but I had to put on a brave face for him.'

By the following day, William was in a coma but his condition had stabilised, so Rebecca remained by his bedside, holding his hand.

'The doctors said he might not be able to reply, but there was still a chance he could hear me,' says Rebecca. 'I held his hand and spoke to him and, at times, he would reply using a hand gesture.'

'I was in a coma, on a high dose of morphine,' says William. 'The only thing I wanted to see was Rebecca when I opened my eyes.

'When I saw her, she gave me a reason to get better, but, if she wasn't there, then there would be no reason. I was doing it for her. It was her love that brought me back to life.'

Against the odds, William got stronger every day. Within a week, he'd started to move his hands and open his eyes.

To begin with, he seemed confused and groggy, and

his family were warned that a major part of his memory would have been lost.

Still, Rebecca continued to chat and tell him stories, hoping it would help him to piece their life together.

A few days later, the doctor wanted to test how much William remembered, so he asked him if he knew who his girlfriend was. flat," and "This is us down our local pub,"' explains Rebecca. 'Sometimes, he'd just look at me with a blank stare, but there were other times when his eyes lit up, which made it all worthwhile.'

Two weeks on, William was moved from intensive care to a high-dependency ward. Rebecca stayed with him

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'When his eyes finally locked on to mine and he pointed towards me, I cried with relief,' says Rebecca.

There were huge gaps in his memory, though. William couldn't remember anything that had happened in the month leading up to the accident, and was unsure what his hobbies and interests were.

That was when Rebecca suggested they write it all down. Before long, she'd made a list of everything that was important to him, written on a whiteboard. She then tested William by asking questions and letting him point to the right answer. Slowly but surely, his memories returned.

'I'd flick through pictures on my phone and says things like, "This was the first day in our every day, with the nurses joking that he'd better marry her once he was better. One day, in fact, when William was still high on morphine, he actually asked the nurses if he could see his wife – meaning Rebecca!

Two months after the accident, William was allowed to leave the hospital. He was still in a wheelchair and needed full-time care, so he moved back in with his mum.

But Rebecca kept up her daily visits, and, in December, just days before William's birthday, he was well enough to come home to her.

'On the morning of his birthday, I was woken up by William handing me a beautiful bouquet,' says Rebecca. 'I couldn't understand why he'd bought it for me when I was supposed to be gifting him.'

> But then William handed her a note, which read, 'There's only one thing I want for my birthday, and that's for you to be my wife.'

Rebecca immediately said yes. The couple now plan to marry this summer, in the place where they had their first date.

'Seeing how quickly things can be snatched from you made us realise that we wanted to move in and get married as soon as we could,' says Rebecca. 'William is nearly back to his old, healthy self, and we have both really learned to appreciate the relationship that we have. We couldn't be happier.'

However, it's been less than four months since Justin and Jennifer confirmed the end of their two-year marriage – and the *Friends* actress was once Selena's 'mentor' in Hollywood.

In 2009, a teenage Selena admitted she 'freaked out' when she met her idol. The pair were often pictured together at high-profile events and, in 2016, Selena said Jen gave her 'a lot of maternal advice'.

So, it's little wonder Jen is said to be miffed by the recent reports.

'It hurts Jen to think that Justin would move on already,'

says a separate source. 'To think of him with anyone else, especially someone so young, and who Jen has a personal relationship with, is painful for her. Jen doesn't want to think about it, and definitely does not believe it.'

In March, the *Mulholland Drive* actor was rumoured to be dating Selena's friend, artist and photographer Petra Collins, 25. At the time, Selena unfollowed Petra on Instagram, after Justin uploaded a picture of them together, and it was believed to be because of her allegiance to Jen.

These romance rumours turned out to be false, and Selena refollowed Petra. Oddly, Petra was also at the hang-out day with Selena and Justin earlier this month, and now fans are speculating that it may have been Selena's jealousy over Petra and Justin's platonic friendship which caused the brief fallout.

MYEYEPATCH ENPOWERED ME

Nineties singer Gabrielle – famed for R&B and soul hits such as Dreams – talks to us about her quirky style, her superstar fans and why she chose her kids over her career...

he's a multi-award-winning, fourtimes platinum artist. But when we meet singer and mum-of-two Gabrielle for a chat at her record label in central London, it's not her showbiz lifestyle keeping her up at night.

'By the time I got home from doing a gig, it was nearly 2am, and then I had to wash my daughter's school skirt,' she laughs, sipping her coffee. 'I'm knackered, I'm balancing that mum-work life.'

This isn't the first time Hackney-born Gabrielle has juggled parenthood with her career. After reaching No.1 with her hits *Dreams* in 1993 and 2000's *Rise*, she gave up her career to concentrate on parenting her son Jordan, now 23, and her 15-year-old daughter Patricia. Her new album, *Under My Skin*, is the first she's written in 11 years.

But although she's famed for her music, it's Gabrielle's unusual style that has intrigued fans over her 25 years in the business. Born with ptosis, a condition which causes her right eyelid to droop, her use of a glitzy eyepatch has also earned her icon status.

And her fans include megastar Adele. Back in 2015, the *Hello* hit-maker, 30, admitted that her mum had once sewed sequins onto an eyepatch for her so she could emulate her idol.

'I saw the Graham Norton interview when she said that, and I texted all my friends, saying, "She spoke my name, she knows who I am!" giggles Gabrielle, 48, who has swept her hair over her eye throughout our interview. 'I am so in awe of her. For her to say that she was inspired by me, I'll take that. I was honoured, she's incredible.'

CONGRATS ON YOUR NEW ALBUM! WHAT WAS YOUR INSPIRATION?

My own life, but I delve into my friends' lives, too. When they're telling me things, I'm like, 'I'm helping you out, but honey, that is some good material!' Luckily, they don't mind. I'm really proud of the songs.

WHAT HAVE YOU BEEN UP TO SINCE YOUR LAST ALBUM?

I'm a mum, so there's not enough hours in the day – I've got the school run to do, breakfasts to make, skirts to wash! I didn't consciously say, 'The time for a comeback is now.' But I was going back into the studio, and I was on a roll. I was paired with the most amazing producers, knocking out about 10 songs in a four-day sitting. One of the songs is called *Every Step.* There's a line in it about all the stars being aligned, which I think is what happened in this case.

DO YOU ENJOY BEING IN THE LIMELIGHT?

When my music career started, I got catapulted into the public eye, and it wasn't something I fully embraced. But I have more presence on social media now. Famous people, such as Lewis Hamilton and RuPaul, will tweet me, people that I love and that I wouldn't think have me on their radar. My manager is ready to stop me if I say anything wrong, though, because I've got no filter!

WHY DO YOU WEAR AN EYEPATCH?

I don't actually need the eyepatch, but when I used to talk to people, I wouldn't look at them, because I didn't want them to focus on my lazy eye. When I first came on the music scene, everyone was like, 'She's got no eyes!' The eyepatch empowered me. I remember going somewhere, and there were these good-looking guys. For the first time in my life, they looked away first. My hair was all sleek, I had this eyepatch,

and I felt amazing – I was a cocky s***! I was a positive role model to children who needed patches, too. When I was at school, I was laughed at because I wanted to sing – they thought I didn't deserve my ambitions because of the way I looked.

DO YOU STILL GET RECOGNISED BY FANS?

Sometimes, when people ask if it's me, I say, 'I wish I was!' I've been using that one for years, and it always works. Most of the time, though, I don't think anybody believes it's really me.

ARE YOUR KIDS PROUD OF YOUR MUSIC COMEBACK?


Yes. My son came to one of my shows recently, which is funny because, years ago, I wasn't cool enough for him. I'm just 'mum' to my daughter, though. I'm not allowed to sing in the house if she's in!

DO YOU REGRET CHOOSING MOTHERHOOD OVER YOUR CAREER?

Not at all. I recall going away to Japan when my son was two. When I got back

home, I wanted to give him a cuddle, but he wasn't having any of it. I remember even asking my mum if my son knew that I was his mum! I was insecure; I couldn't take it. So I went to all their school plays. I didn't want anyone else putting my child to bed. I needed that time out with my babies.

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GRILED HALLOUMI BURGER WITH SMASHED AVOCADO

It's National BBQ Week next week, so we thought we'd get in early with this delicious veggie burger that is super-simple, quick to make and packed with flavour



INGREDIENTS

FOR THE SEASONING 1tsp sumac Pinch of cayenne pepper 1tsp paprika FOR THE SMASHED **AVOCADO** 2 super-ripe avocados Juice of 1 lime FOR THE BURGERS 4 x halloumi cheese slices, 2cm thick Olive oil, for drizzling 4 burger buns Handful of mint leaves, chopped Pomegranate molasses, to drizzle 2 ripe tomatoes, sliced Bunch of rocket

Serves 4

METHOD 🐋 Mix all the seasoning spices together in a bowl. Halve the avocados, remove the pits and, using a large spoon, pull the ripe flesh away from the skin and empty into a bowl. Using the back of the spoon, smash the avocado to a chunky paste. Pour in the lime juice, give it a light mix and set aside.

→ Lay the halloumi slabs on a plate, and drizzle olive oil on both sides. Lightly sprinkle the cheese with the seasoning mix. Once seasoned, place the slabs over direct heat, and grill for a couple of minutes on one side until you have some lovely golden grill marks. Flip and repeat. Everything happens pretty quickly, so this is a good time to toast your burger buns on the grill. -> Assembly time! Spoon the avocado onto the four bun bases. 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SWEET TALK Is dark chocolate really good for your health? Jessie, Bath

In moderation, yes. Dark chocolate is high in antioxidant flavonoids, which can slow down cell damage. Recent studies have suggested it may improve vision as well as helping prevent cancer, heart disease, diabetes, dementia, erectile dysfunction and depression. Eating dark chocolate could also improve the response of the immune system and memory.

It's not the sugar but the flavonoids in the cacao that appear to give you a buzz. You can also find flavonoids in blackcurrants, grapes, aubergines and red wine. Just remember what your granny said... 'Variety is the spice of life, and a little of what you fancy does you good.'

GOLDEN YEARS

How much longer will I live with a healthy lifestyle? Julie, Sheffield

Possibly 10 years. American researchers divided people into how many of the five top healthy habits they adopted. Number one, not smoking. Two, maintaining a healthy weight. Three, doing at least 30 minutes of moderate exercise a day. Four, eating a healthy diet, high in fruit, veg and whole grains, and low in red meat, saturated fats and sugar. Five, not drinking more than 14 units a week. Less than two per cent did all five, but they did live, on average, a decade longer than the least healthy. Adopting any of 'the big five' should improve the quality and length of your life.

WHAT ARE THE COMMONEST CANCER MYTHS? Marie, Dublin

At present, we have no good scientific evidence that cancer is caused by any of the following: drinking from plastic bottles, eating food containing artificial sweeteners, eating genetically modified food, eating food containing additives, using microwave ovens, aerosol containers, mobile phones or cleaning products, living near power

lines, feeling stressed, suffering physical trauma or exposure to electromagnetic frequencies. However, science changes over time; maybe, in the future, we will discover some of these things are not good for our health. Also, we are individuals. If you react badly to an individual product or environment, you should try to avoid it. Everything we do has some risk attached to it. We just have to manage the risks and live with them.

COLD SHOULDER What is fat freezing and does it make you lose weight?

Fran, Edinburgh Fat freezing (aka cryogenic lipolysis) is a non-surgical alternative to liposuction, supposed to destroy fat cells to aid weight loss. Fat cells are frozen for a period of time on your tummy, thighs, arms or other 'problem areas', and you sit for up to two hours 'while cooling paddles suction the skin and crystallise fat cells'. If it's done safely, by a professional, some people report that they lose problem fat, but it varies a lot. As one expert put it, 'At best, you get mild fat reduction. I would emphasise the word "mild".

Should I show my kids porn and explain how abnormal it is? Jon, London

It's very important that as parents, we talk to our children about growing up, changes in their bodies, relationships, love, sex, intimacy, contraception, consent and having the confidence to say both 'yes' and 'no', which includes what they see and do on the internet. Some sex educators argue that porn should be shown to children who wish to see it, with a trained counsellor explaining how abnormal and unrealistic it is. Very few parents will feel comfortable doing this but, if you have talked about love, sex and relationships with your child, it's easier to talk about the dangerous fantasies of porn. Many kids start viewing porn as young as 11, even if you have parental filters in place. They need our guidance to be resilient and stand up to abuse. There's good advice at esafety.gov.au


