


bel fully American," previews Bradley, "because he wants to leave his English side behind."

Diamont: "I originally thought it was going to be more like a [parenting guide], but as I began to get into it, I realized that all my life experiences informed the things that I've advised my kids about. So it really did become a memoir as well as being a how-to book in a way that isn't preachy, so to speak."



Did you have help from a professional writer? **Diamont:** "Initially, I had a ghost writer, because it just wasn't something I thought I would — or could - do on my own. So instead, I sat down and wrote it myself, which I didn't anticipate having to do. Most people could use a ghost writer and say, 'This is fine,' but I couldn't have 'fine.' I couldn't have 'okay.' sonal for me and too intimate, so I had to do it myself."

It took a lot of mental and emotional energy, and there were days when I'd think, 'God, I don't want to sit down again and dwell on this and start crying,' which was my experience more than once in writing the

Camryn Grimes (Mariah) shares the thrill of her second Emmy win

eeks prior to this year's Daytime Emmys, THE YOUNG & THE RESTLESS' Camryn Grimes (Mariah) spent much of her time dismissing her chances of snagging the statuette for Outstanding Supporting Actress. So she was more than a little shocked when her name was called out on the night in question. "All I heard was my first name, and then everybody from Y&R sort of leapt up!" she recalls with a laugh. "Robert Adamson (ex-Noah), who was my date for the evening, yelled in my ear, and I was like, 'Oh, God, here we go!'

"I didn't have a speech prepared, so it looked like I was making a beeline for the stage, but I was really like, 'Oh God! Now I have to think of something to say!" she adds. "I didn't turn and focus on anyone around me. I was like, 'What do I do?!?"

Hitting A High Note

Winning another Emmy 18 years after she won in the Outstanding Younger Actress category puts Grimes in a reflective mood. "If I were being perfectly honest, having a career that I've had that spans now a little over 20 years — with all the normal peaks and valleys of this crazy business — you do start to wonder if you're as good as an adult as I was when I was younger," she confesses. "Do I still have it? Or was [the previous award] a circumstantial fluke? Especially when you're going through your teenage years and early 20s, all these doubts come into play when you think about your career. You think, 'Can I ever do that again? Am I as good now as everyone thought I was back then?' I think that's normal."

with one of the evening's top honors certainly goes a long way toward easing any concerns or insecurities that Grimes may have been feeling! "Something like this shouldn't be validating - I should feel validated on my own... which I do, for the most part — but it is very validating!" she laughs. "It's like, 'Okay, I can put aside all those insecurities and doubts and just do my job!""

Honor Role

Speaking of the job, Grimes has seen her alter ego go through quite an evolution since she returned to Y&R to play Mariah in 2014, "After it was revealed that I was Cassie's twin, I feel like they really didn't know what to do with me. I was so lucky they paired me with Greg Rikaart (ex-Kevin; now Leo, DAYS OF OUR LIVES), because that gave me a chance to do comedy," she shares. "Comedy didn't come naturally to me, and a lot of what I learned, I learned from Greg.

"I really credit my character's longterm success to him," she continues, "to how brilliant he is and how much work he and I put into crafting the Kevin and Mariah storyline."

As much as she enjoyed tickling the audience's funny bone, the Emmy winner admits that she's loved getting the chance to return to her dramatic roots.

"Mariah has softened a lot since she came on." says her portrayer.

Mariah was passed out when Nikki murdered J.T., and Victoria, Phyllis and Sharon helped her dispose of the body — which is just fine with Grimes, "Mariah doesn't need to be an accomplice to murder! She's got enough to deal with!"

for which she thanks executive producer/headwriter Mal Young, "I have loved every writer since I've been back," she insists. "Everybody has a different take on things, but I think when Mal came on — and I have no idea why — he took an interest in this character, Mariah, and in exploring her more. That's why I got this story [between Mariah and Tessa]. And I am forever grateful!

"Never in a million years did I think I'd be back [after Cassie flat-lined] or that my life would come so full circle," she continues quietly. "It makes me emotional just to think about how lucky I've been. I do not take that for granted!"




If simple things blow the toddler's mind, Clifton can only imagine how something of a bigger magnitude might rock his little


tell them, 'You're helping Dad stay in shape."


The actor, who has three chil-

Gina Tognoni (Phyllis, Y&R) makes sure to connect with her dad, Edward, on Father's Day musings


