a circuit workout, and if you're anything like me and get bored easily then this is an essential element of any workout! If you're looking for the "ultimate cardio blast" that activates every muscle in your body, then try this little celebrity body circuit below, and let me know how you go! To complete my "celebrity body" workout, you need to run through exercises one to five, resting for a maximum of 15-30 seconds between each exercise, and performing 20 reps of each to a challenging intensity.



New movie *The Bookshop* turns another page on the big screen's enduring love affair with these beloved shops, wherever they are in the world.

here's a romantic notion in the new movie *The Bookshop* about how vital and engaging the neighbourhood bookstore can be to a community. The flick, starring **Emily Mortimer**, **Bill Nighy** and **Patricia Clarkson**, tells of events in a staid coastal town in England where a woman fulfils her dream of opening a bookshop.



While the story explores the drama as she attempts to settle into the tightknit community, chewing up the scenery are the stunning locations of **Portaferry**, **County Down**, in green and gorgeous **Northern Ireland**.

Portaferry, about an hour's drive from the capital Belfast, is a good-looking gem famed as a fishing village and for its grand Georgian buildings. Standing guard over the town is the sentinel-like 16th century Portaferry Castle, which also overlooks the sprawling Strangford Lough waterway.

The Bookshop continues a fine tradition of movies that have a bookstore at the core of its tale, kickstarting a new wave of tourism among movie lovers keen to take in the evocative locales for themselves.

Take the grand Paris institution Shakespeare & Company, which is the

starting point for the romantic escapade of *Before Sunset*, starring **Ethan Hawke** and **Julie Delpy**. This is where the former lovers were reunited, as Jesse (Ethan) was launching his book about his brief affair with Celine (Julie). From there, the

pair venture out to explore pretty Paris.

This historic bookshop, once the Paris hangout of such literary greats as **Ernest Hemingway**, is an English-

language store on the banks of the Seine, opposite Notre-Dame Cathedral. It's fascinating to see where Before Sunset was shot because the store's maze of shelves and hallways must've presented quite a challenge to get a camera crew inside!

One movie bookshop became so famous it was for a time one of London's most visited tourist spots. Notting Hill, starring **Hugh Grant** and Julie Roberts, told the story of a travel bookshop owner who falls in love with a sexv Hollywood movie star. The location used was at 142 Portobello Road. which was formerly the Nicholls Antique Arcade, and now trades as a shoe and gift shop.

Marks & Co was one of London's most famous bookshops, located at 84 Charing Cross Road. That address was also the title of the movie classic, telling the true story of the intertwining lives of a New York writer Helene (Anne Bancroft) and the London bookstore manager Frank (Anthony Hopkins).

As the real bookshop closed in the early 1970s, the shop scenes in the movie were recreated in a film studio. Today a restaurant occupies the site of the old bookshop, but a plaque on the wall pays tribute to the enduring fame of the site, thanks to the success of the movie and book of 84 Charing Cross Road.

In You've Got Mail, Meg
Ryan and Tom Hanks were
the rival New York bookstore
owners who fought tooth and nail
for their customers. For all the
romance of Meg's children's
bookstore, the reality is the
location at 103 West 69th Street
was actually Maya Shaper's
Cheese and Antique shop!

However, the filmmakers liked the quaint look of the antique shop so much, they turned it in a bookshop for the movie. After the crew packed up, it became an antique store once again, but movie lovers still like to take a snap in front of it!

The stylish ladies of Sex and the City would often pop into a bookshop. Whether it was for the Unoriginal Sin episode when Charlotte was shopping for self-help books, or the Cover Girl episode when Carrie and Samantha were checking out other book covers in preparation for the launch of Carrie's tome, Strand Books at 828 Broadway near Union Square in New York was always their first choice.

This book barn, which opened in 1927, is a New York landmark of new and used books – it boasts it shelves contains "18 miles of books!". This is the perfect place to get lost in literature for a couple of hours, surrounded by the words of the world's greatest writers. And whether on screen or in real life, that's always a very good time indeed! **TVS**






Vale Cornelia


