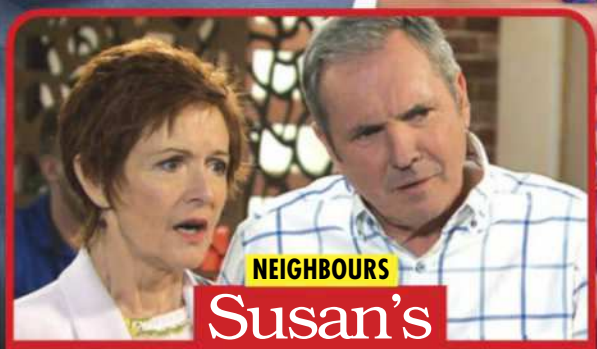

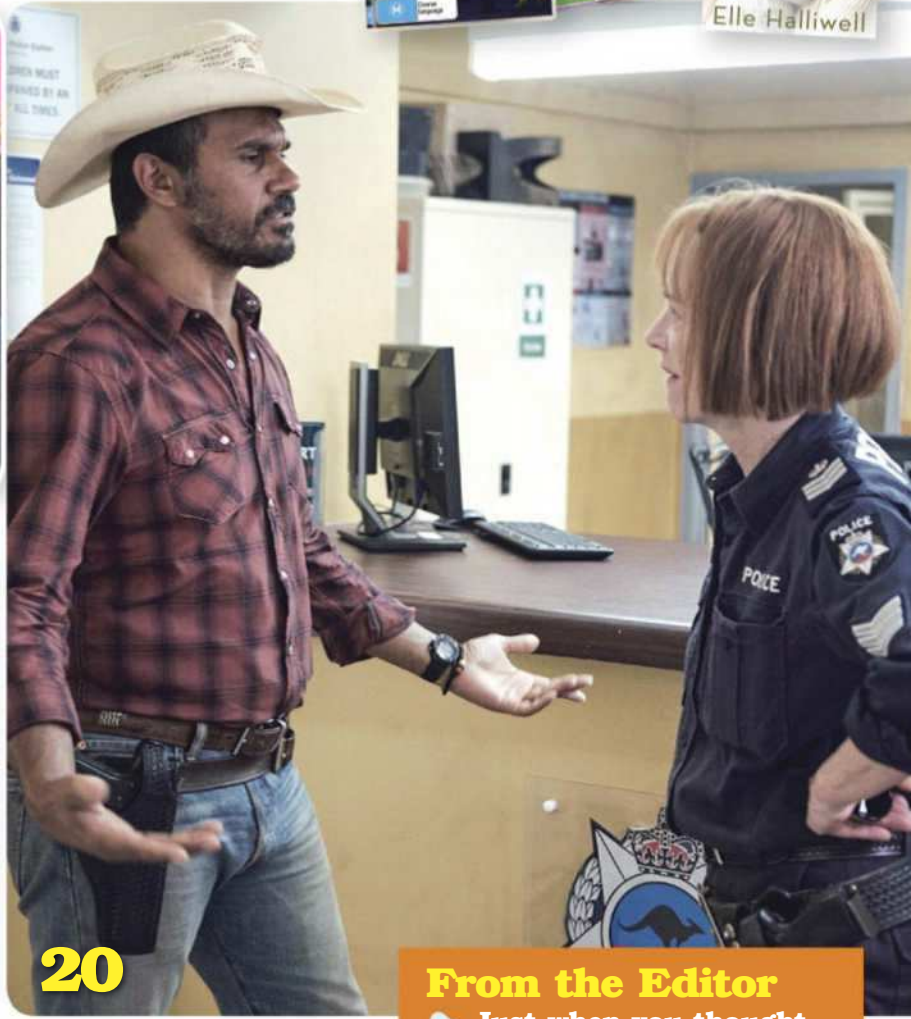

## From the Editor

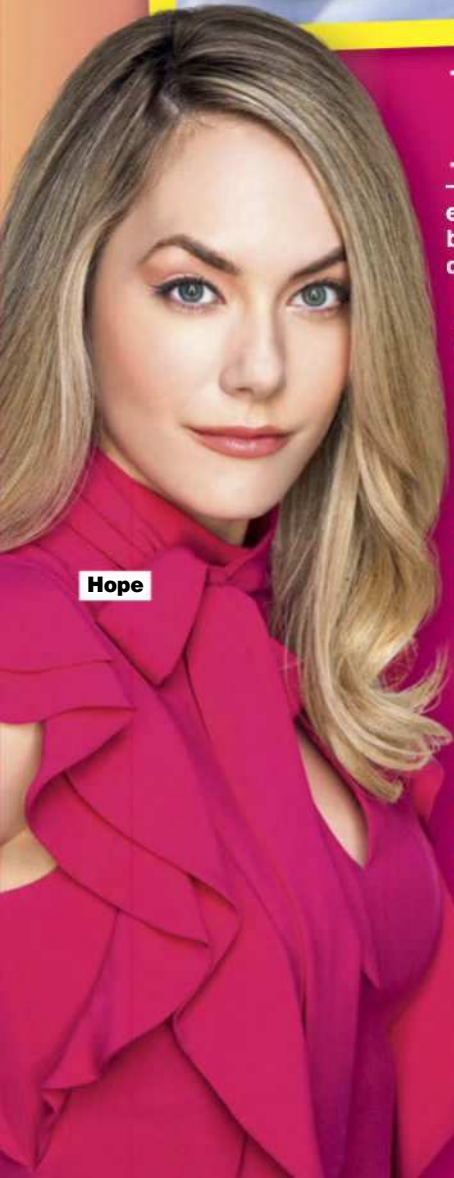

A quick workout will warm you up and do you good this winter!

Yep, we're well and truly in that challenging time of year again as the days get shorter and colder and our motivation to exercise and eat healthily can also start to diminish! The good news is that it doesn't need to be tricky or take a lot of time to stay in superstar shape with this fast-tracked super-circuit workout. The goal over winter is to maintain all that hard work you've put into your body over the summer, so when winter's done and dusted, your fab figure isn't! This time out I share my top tips not just for staying stay in shape over the dead of winter, but also for doing it quickly and upping those energy levels.

## Example workout

For each exercise use bodyweight, dumbbells or anything else you have handy to add resistance and increase the workout intensity.

**Backward stepping lunges** for legs

**Wide squats** target the inner thigh

**Shoulder presses** target the upper body

**Push-ups** for chest and shoulders

**Bicep curls** for the arms

stay in great shape. Include more short-duration, high-intensity workouts into your weekly routine for not only maintenance, but a raft of other benefits, too. The big pluses of short, high-intensity workouts come with your post-recovery state – if you're working harder you're going to have a slightly elevated heart and metabolic rate, meaning you're burning more calories over the recovery period as well as when you're actually exercising. And that's good news! Some studies have

shown that HIIT burns nine times more fat than traditional cardiovascular exercise and keeps your metabolism elevated for a period of more than 24 hours afterwards! This means you're going to keep burning calories long after you've finished exercising.

## Circuit workouts

I'm a huge fan of circuits because they just work so well and keep you switched on and motivated. Time just flies by in

a circuit workout, and if you're anything like me and get bored easily then this is an essential element of any workout! If you're looking for the "ultimate cardio blast" that activates every muscle in your body, then try this little celebrity body circuit below, and let me know how you go! To complete my "celebrity body" workout, you need to run through exercises one to five, resting for a maximum of 15-30 seconds between each exercise, and performing 20 reps of each to a challenging intensity.

## Feel the burn

If you're looking to stay in shape over the winter months, your workouts can get shorter, but they still need to maintain intensity. HIIT (high-intensity interval training) will help you



# sweet

Complete exercises one to five for three sets in total. Then perform your cardio and core tabata exercises for 20 seconds work, 10 seconds recovery, over eight exercises. This workout should take 20-30 minutes.

## Gimme five

To get started, choose five exercises you want to use for your workout, including one for each body part: back, shoulders, legs, chest, arms. The first run-through will be your warm-up set, using a light-to-moderate weight for each exercise; once that's complete choose a more challenging weight that will have you failing on the last few repetitions for each exercise. I have included an example workout at left, but the great thing about the celebrity body circuit is you can easily change the exercises for variety and to target different body parts. **TVS**



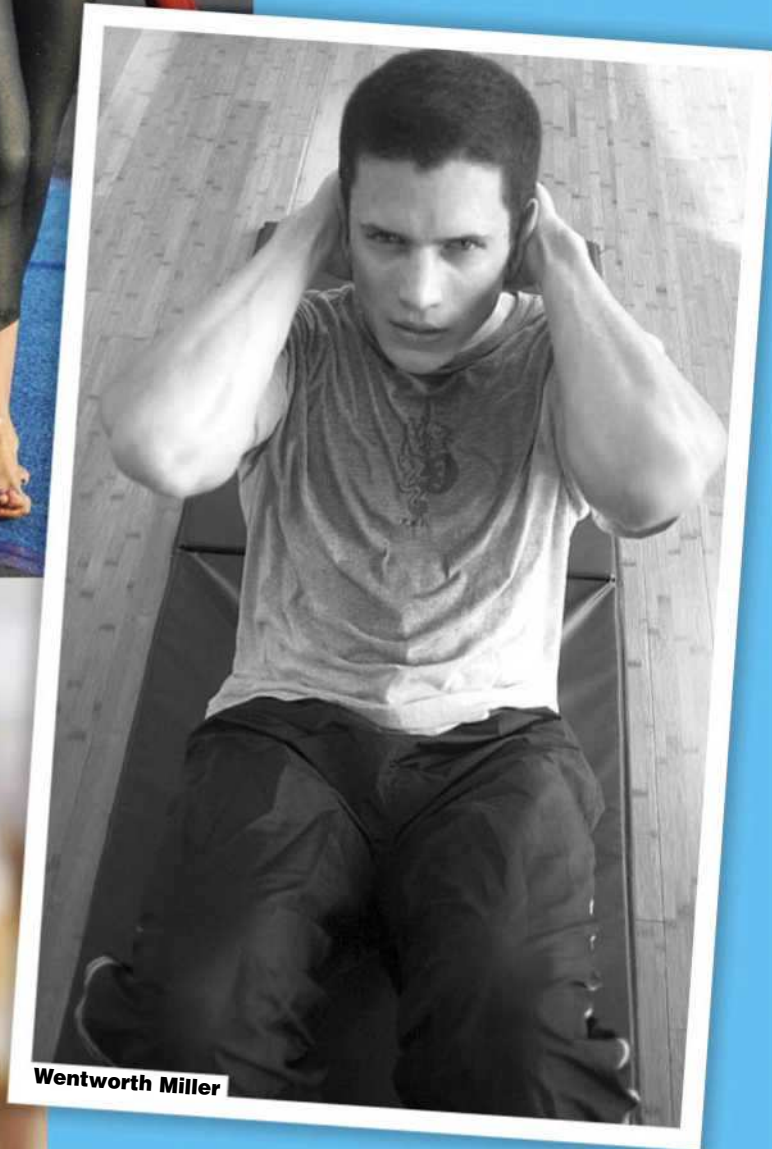

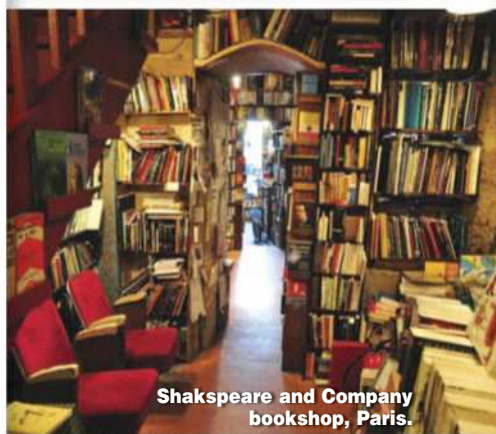

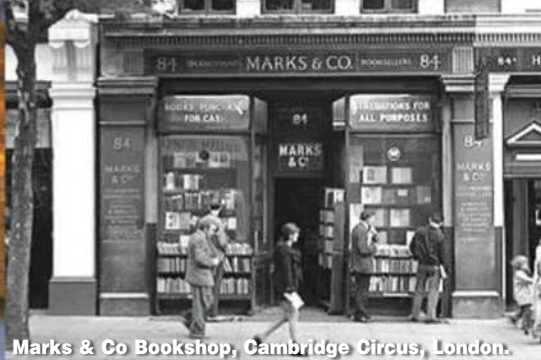

One movie bookshop became so famous it was for a time one of London's most visited tourist spots. *Notting Hill*, starring **Hugh Grant** and **Julie Roberts**, told the story of a travel bookshop owner who falls in love with a sexy Hollywood movie star. The location used was at **142 Portobello Road**, which was formerly the Nicholls Antique Arcade, and now trades as a shoe and gift shop.

**Marks & Co** was one of London's most famous bookshops, located at **84 Charing Cross Road**. That address was also the title of the movie classic, telling the true story of the intertwining lives of a New York writer Helene (**Anne Bancroft**) and the London bookstore manager Frank (**Anthony Hopkins**).

As the real bookshop closed in the early 1970s, the shop scenes in the movie were recreated in a film studio. Today a restaurant occupies the site of the old bookshop, but a plaque on the wall pays tribute to the enduring fame of the site, thanks to the success of the movie and book of *84 Charing Cross Road*.

In *You've Got Mail*, **Meg Ryan** and **Tom Hanks** were the rival New York bookstore owners who fought tooth and nail for their customers. For all the romance of Meg's children's bookstore, the reality is the location at **103 West 69th Street** was actually Maya Shaper's Cheese and Antique shop!

However, the filmmakers liked the quaint look of the antique shop so much, they turned it in a bookshop for the movie. After the crew packed up, it became an antique store once again, but movie lovers still like to take a snap in front of it!

The stylish ladies of *Sex and the City* would often pop into a bookshop. Whether it was for the *Unoriginal Sin* episode when **Charlotte** was shopping for self-help books, or the *Cover Girl* episode when **Carrie** and **Samantha** were checking out other book covers in preparation for the launch of Carrie's tome, **Strand Books at 828 Broadway** near Union Square in New York was always their first choice.

This book barn, which opened in 1927, is a New York landmark of new and used books – it boasts it shelves contains "18 miles of books!" 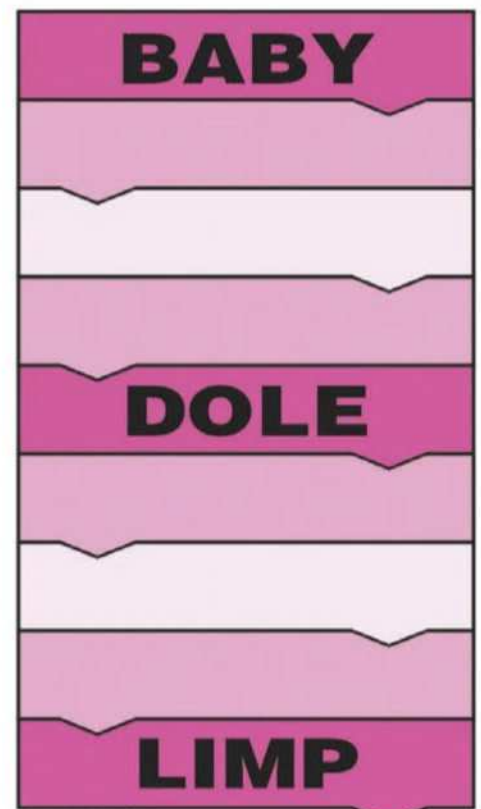
