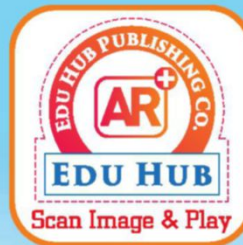

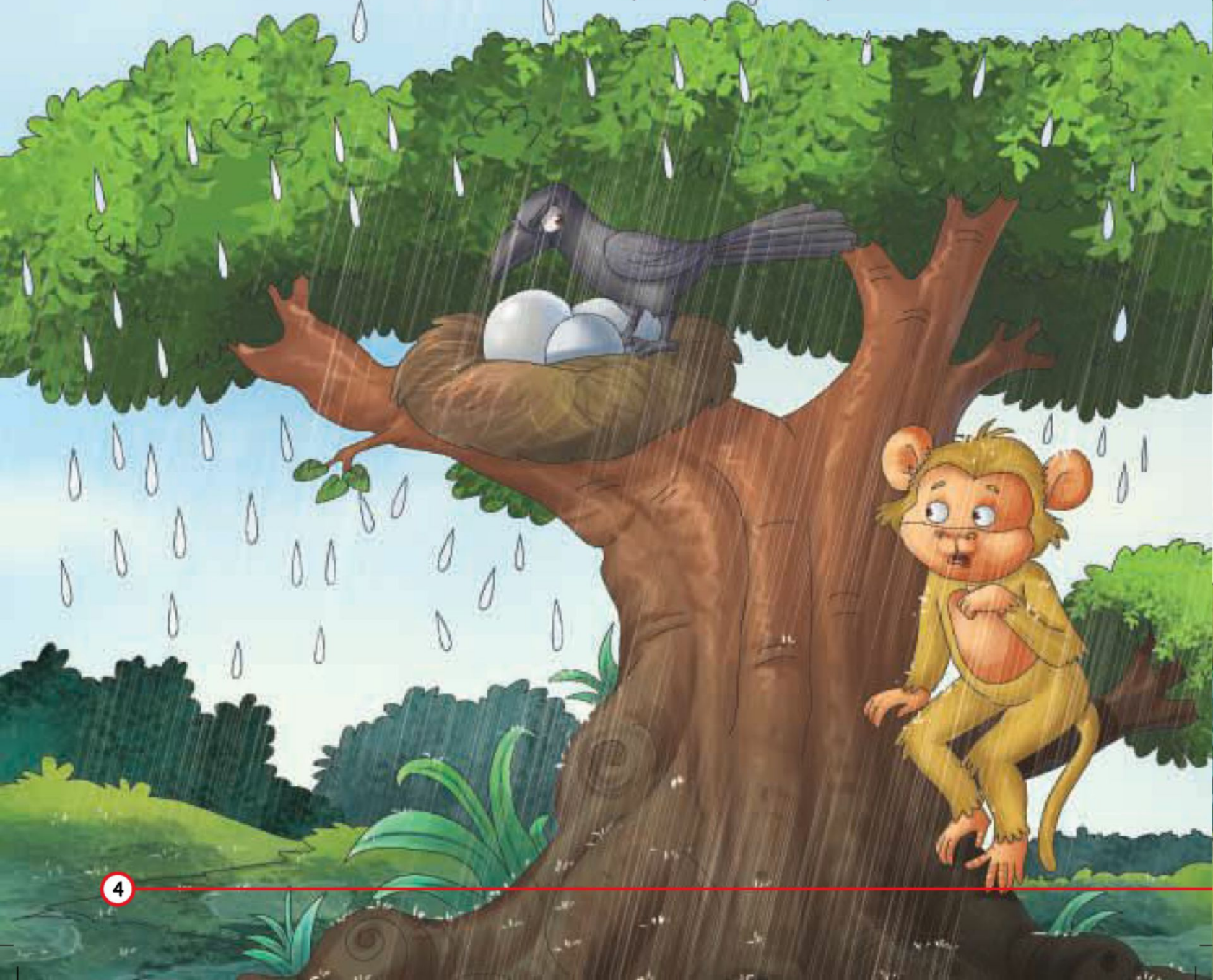


# Story Time

# Tecnia International School

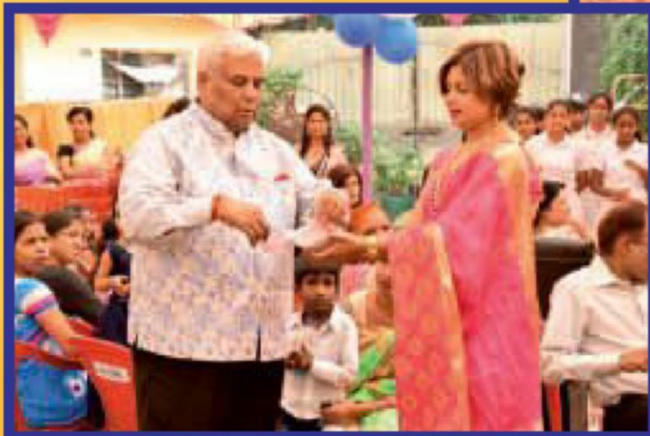


## **FASHION SHOW**
