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




#### STR BEGINS A NEW LOVE STORY

#### **VERDICT**

H Vinoth has skillfully woven a social message into this thriller of a film. The movie is long and winding, but for those who love police adevntures, Theeran Adhigaram Ondru has lots to offer in terms of suspense, action and bloodsheed. Karthi is the body and soul of the movie. He carries this gritty tale on his shoulders and keeps us interested in the plot. The barren desert is an unforgiving terrain, and Karthi has clearly braved the heat and harsh climate. At all times he comes out on top, keeping the movie moving and engaging with his performance.

#### WHAT WE LIKED:

Director H. Vinoth has skilfully balanced the social message in the movie and creates a huge respect for the police department without showcasing them as superheroes or as those who don't work at all. The striking balance with catchy dialogs change when the hunt begins and the attention to detail given for the gangs of robbers who operate from Sambal area will definitely blow the minds of audience who love such depth to their movies.

#### WHAT WE'D SKIP:

The movie is long. The length is what gets to you. The movie would have been so much better if the narrative had been taut. A few more snips would have added to the pace as well. Audience come to police stories expecting

fast cuts, high-speed chases and quick flow of action. That section of the audience is bound to get impatient in spite of the killer performances of the lead players.

#### THE CHARACTERS:

Theeran Adhigaram Ondru is Karthi's show all the way. Karthi has a fantastic screen presence and he makes sure that his lines, his look and his acting are perfect. Casting is top notch with Bose Venkat being the best pick for his seamless acting. The villain group from Northern India and police squad make the movie as believable as it can get. Rakul Preet Singh sticks to her role with a charm.

#### **TECH CHECK:**

Cinematographer Sathyan Sooryan and music director Ghibran have competed with each other, while his camera travels through dry lands searching for answers, the loud and thumping BGM elevates the tension. Dhilip Subburayan's stunt need to be mentioned. There is a certain authenticity in every punch that makes the final showdown satisfying. The camera, the music and the stunts come together brilliantly, leaving us breathless.

#### WHAT WE LIKED:

Udhayanidhi Stalin as Madhu, does a great job. His acting has truly matured - he is subtle, yet strong. Soori is essentially the comedian in the story, yet he pulls off a key role supporting the hero throughout. Daniel Balaji and RK Suresh's respective performance help move the story effortlessly. Kudos to Gaurav's story and screenplay for being smart and thrilling. There aren't any logical loopholes and a sensible narration ensures you don't get annoyed at any point of the flick. WHAT WE'D SKIP:



The run-time could have been lesser. Even though Manjima Mohan has done her part well, the romance is not an essential element in the plot and could have been edited further.

#### VERDICT

Ippadai Vellum is one of Udhayanidhi's best performances. A job well done. The biggest plus of Ippadai Vellum is that the movie treats audience with respect and does not undermine their intelligence. On the whole a well-made thriller.

But soon a series of strange events take place leading them to believe that Jenny believes she is possessed. Being a man of science Krish does not immediately accept the idea of a ghost. His colleague, a psychiatrist suggests they fake an exorcism in order to help the girl come out of her fears. However, during the fake ceremony, all hell breaks loose. They realise that there is an inexplicable dark force at play. And soon everyone who has come in contact with Jenny start seeing things. Lakshmi who is pregnant has a near fatal fall because of an apparition. Krish and his colleague attempt to get to the bottom of the haunting and try to chase away the dark spirit.

#### **WHAT WE LIKED:**

The movie is a full-blown horror movie. There are hideous ghosts and gruesome deaths to send chills down your spine even if you are catching the matinee show! Millind and Siddharth deserve a pat on the back for reviving the horror genre, for all we get these days are

comedy-horror flicks that are neither here nor there. The art, VFX and makeup departments need special mention. They have done a terrific job in terrifying the audience!

#### WHAT WE'D SKIP:

The makers were really prepared for the A Certificate from the Censor Board, because they have not bothered to go easy on the gruesome details of the 'ghost' and the deaths. Two hours of this however, does tend to make you nauseous.

#### **VERDICT**

If you can stomach the gore for two hours, if you are a hardcore horror buff, if you are fed-up with the ridiculous numberofpseudo-horrorflicksthathave released in the last five years, then this one is a refreshing change. And even if you are not a big fan of the horror genre, you will surely enjoy the thrills and chills. The movie has taken inspiration from Hollywood movies such as Conjuring and Excorcist, but it has definitely raised the bar for Indian horror flicks.

#### WHAT WE LIKED:

Well, we loved the racey pace. But what we loved and are grateful for the most is that director Meera Kathiravan did not feel compelled to add a couple of songs just to stick to the masala formula. Kudos to that! There is the kuthu song by T Rajendar, but fortunately it is quite enjoyable.

#### WHAT WE'D SKIP:

While we totally appreciate the director's attempt to stay away from cliches we wish he had steered a way from the many coincidental meetings in the story. There are times that we feel that two characters are put at the same place just to move the story forward and are not brought there by the story.

#### **VERDICT**

Krishna does a good job, as do Vidharth and Dhansika. Applause to Venkat Prabhu and Sarah as well. Vizhithiru is primarily a thriller and it does bring you to the edge of the seat in anticipation. The movie is technically sound and most of the knots are neatly untied, which means the director has written his story well. The movie is totally worth a watch. Thumbs up & three cheers!

with finesse! Most of the movie is shot at night and the cinematographer has lit up the shots in such a way that there is always an element of suspense around the edges. D. Imman's background score is a major asset. It fills in the gaps and enhances the suspense.

#### WHAT WE'D SKIP:

Though the movie is enjoyable, some scenes and situations remind us of Suseenthiran's previous movies in this genre. He needs to relook at his shot designing. And we hope that next time he casts Vikranth, he will give him the lead, since he does bring out the best in the actor.

Good entertainment. Once more Suseenthiran has proved that he can definitely take an action movie that has some amount of drama in it as well. His films generally pit a common guy against a seemingly insurmountable villain. Suseenthiran has mastered that genre and has given one more hit. Congratulations!








## REWARDING THE LEGENDS

Anup Ruben's music for Manamearned him the Best Music Composer award and Krishna Vamsi won the Best Story Writer Award for Govindudu Andarivadele.





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ALATTA CINEMA: WHY HAVE YOU STAYED AWAY FROM TAMIL CINEMA FOR SO LONG? RAKUL PREET: I know, it's been a while right.

But it's not like I've just been sitting around and avoiding every Kollywood offer that came my way. I did Thadayara Thakka and Pudhyugam a while ago and then I just started getting interesting offers in Telugu cinema. I too was waiting for something good to come up in Tamil as well, and that's when Spyder happened. After Spyder, I feel the opportunities in Tamil have increased.

## GC: AND THAT WOULD BRING US TO THEERAN ADHIGARAM ONDRU. WHAT EXCITED YOU ABOUT THE MOVIE?

RP: The story is based on true events. It's a case that was being investigated between 1995 and 2005. I feel it's important to tell people such stories about real events and real heroes. The people should be aware of the things going on around them - the true stories. Also I loved the character that I was offered. It was something I have never done before. It was fun as well as new - that really got me hooked. And when I was told the story, I had already watched Sathuranga Vettai by director Vinodh. I liked the way the screenplay had been written. So I was more than happy to be a part of his next movie.

## GC: DID YOU CONNECT ON SOME LEVEL WITH THE CHARACTER YOU PLAYED IN THEERAN ADHIGARAM ONRU?

RP: Not at all. In Theeran Adhigaran Onru, I play a Tamil girl from a lower-middle class family. I have failed multiple times in school. I have no interest in studying. yet whenever I am called to do some householed chores, I immediately pick up my text books and pretend to be busy. I'm more interested in going to the movies than to school. And everytime the topic of marriage crops up. I say that I wish to puruse a Masters degree and have no time for marriage. These simple moments make up the personality of the character I play, which is very different from who I am and different from any role that I have played so far. I also really liked the romance in the movie, the way the love-story was designed by the director. The love-scenes as realistic as they may seem are too good to be true! Every time he described the scene I would be awed by the amount of love the two characters had for each and how they showed it. Karthi and me used to tease Vinodh saying the scenes were inspired by his married life, for he had just gotten married, like the characters in the movie!

## GC: WE HEAR THAT YOUR CO-STAR KARTHI WAS ALSO YOUR TAMIL TEACHER! WHAT WAS IT LIKE WORKING WITH HIM?

**RP:** He is a very grounded guy. He has absolutely no 'hero image' of himself. He was there to help me whenever I needed it. I used to put in a lot of effort to learn my lines in Tamil, but somehow during the take I would forget something. And before anyone else could prompt me, Karthi himself would tell me what my line was! That was amazing because it meant he knew every dialog in the movie! His passion and hardwork is something else!

## GC: WHAT KIND OF A RAPPORT DID THE TWO OF YOU SHARE? IT HAS BEEN SAID THAT HE CRACKS UP HIS CO-STARS BETWEEN SHOTS...

**RP:** Absolutely! He is a fun guy and most of the scenes that we share is also fun. The two characters thrive off each other's personalities. It's not just about saying your lines and conveying a messagae. The chemistry had to work, for the characters to work. And Karthi is as helpful and supportive as it gets.

#### GC: HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE DIRECTOR VINDOH?

RP: He is absolutely focused. and unwavering. Vinodh is very clear about what he wants. If he has planned a certain sequence to last for one mintue, even if it took ten seconds more, he would go in for a retake, cause he was rock sure that it was worth only a minute. He has seen to it that the editing is taut, giving enough weightage to the various parts of the movie. These are defnitely his strong points. Another thing is knowing where to draw the line in commercialising a film that is based on a true story. As a director you need to strike a balance between 'commercial elements' and telling the truth like it is without taking too much of 'cinematic privileges'. Vinodh has it all figured out and he will pursue it. Unswerving, Unyielding.

## GC: SPYDER, YOUR PREVIOUS FILM AND THEERAN ADHIGARAM ONRU, ARE BOTH BILINGUALS. HOW DOES MAKING A BILINGUAL IMPACT YOU?

**RP:** By completely stressing you out! It definitely is extremely difficult to work on the same movie in two different languages (that are not my mother-tongue)

simultaneously. Of course, doing the movie in two languages means that you reach a bigger audience, which is great for everybody, but it is really challenging. The most difficult thing for me and even for Mahesh Babu was shooting the songs. We would have to learn different moves for the same line, while lip-syncing to different lyrics as well. We would need longer breaks during the switch from language to the other, so that we too could mentally make the switch. But these challenges are what make the job exciting, right!

#### GC: WHAT LESSON IN CINEMA DID YOU LEARN ON THE SETS OF SPYDER FROM **DIRECTOR AR MURUGADOSS?**

RP: Learning is a continuous process. You can't quite pinpoint any one particular thing that you have learnt from one person. Most of the time you don't realise you have learnt something, you naturally imbibe it from the people you meet and the situations you experience. When I look back at my journey in cinema from my first film to now, I sense that I have matured in the art of acting. How and who taught me, I cannot tell you specifically. It's from everyone, even the people who interview me maybe!

#### **GC: YOU DID THE REMAKE OF THANI ORUVAN IN TELUGU - DRUVA. HOW DID** YOU APPROACH THE CHARACTER?

RP: I watched Thani Oruvan much before the offer to act in Druva came to me. I loved the movie. And Navantara is one of my most favourite actresses, and she had set a benchmark already for the character, which I had to beat. Remaking a hit film is tricky for the actors and the makers. But I was sure I did not want to imitate the original. After I signing on Druva, I dd not watch Thani Oruvan again. I did not want to even accidently copy what Nayantara had done.


#### GC: WHAT ARE YOU EXPECTATIONS FROM YOURSELF?

RP: I just want to enjoy the work that I do. You cannot plan everything. I don't have finite goals that I'm going after. I love to work. If I believe in what I'm doing, I can work even for 24 hours non-stop. I just need to enjoy the job.

#### KAANCHAN PRASHANTH SHARES EXCERPTS FROM A CONVERSATION WITH PRABHUDEVA...

GALATTA CINEMA: AFTER QUITE A GAP WE SAW YOU IN A TAMIL FILM - DEVI. THE MOVIE WAS RECEIVED WELL. DID YOU REALISE THAT WE TRULY MISSED YOU HERE DOWN SOUTH? PRABHU DEVA: In the pre-release promotions, while doing interviews, I got the feeling that I was missed. That the people wanted to see me in Tamil movies again. It was a good feeling and I'm happy I did it.

#### GC: IN YOUR ABSENCE SEVERAL NEW HEROES HAVE EMERGED. DID THAT GIVE YOU A SENSE OF INSECURITY?

PD: I wouldn't say insecurity. But just before the release, I did have my doubts. People may not have forgotten me, but they were definitely not that much in touch with me because they had not seen me. So I was a bit worried if they would immediately accept me again. I did have some apprehensions and doubts as the release date for Devi drew near. But then on the day of the release, when I visited the theatres to see how the movie was faring, I was relieved to hear the sound of applause. The claps were reassuring.

#### GC: DID YOU FEEL GUILTY FOR HAVING **IGNORED US?**

PD: No, no. I did not ignore the South. I did not have a predefined plan to just go off to Bollywood. Nothing like that. I just did one movie and then went with the flow. I honestly did not stop to strategise. But now that I have started working in Tamil movies, I feel really happy.

#### GC: EVERSINCE DEVI YOU HAVE BEEN SIGNING ON TAMIL FILMS IN A FLURRY. AREN'T YOU BOTHERED THAT BOLLYWOOD WILL FORGET YOU?

PD: No, I don't really think that way. Moreover, I will begin working on my next Hindi movie by November. I am in talks with a Bollywood producer and when the details are sorted, I will share the news with the world.

#### GC: WE OFTEN HEAR ACTORS DESCRIBING THEIR DIRECTORS AS DRAMATIC ACTORS THEMSELVES, WHEN EXPLAINING A SCENE. BUT YOU DON'T TALK MUCH. WHAT'S YOUR METHOD OF WORKING?

PD: The same way I get actors to dance! Having been a choreographer and worked with several actors, I know how to extract work from them.

I may not chit-chat, but I definitely know how to act out a scene and get the actor to perform.

#### GC: HOW MUCH FREEDOM DO YOU GIVE THE ACTORS. ONCE YOU HAVE CONVEYED WHAT'S ON YOUR MIND?

PD: I give them freedom, of course. The actors have to feel comfortable doing the role, so I welcome their suggestions. See, as the director I am looking at the whole movie. I know what every scene is about. I already have a picture in my head. But when someone comes with a newer perspective, I cannot simply ignore it because I have the power to do it. I pay attention to every small detail.



#### GC: WHAT'S MORE DIFFICULT TO TEACH: DANCE OR ACTING?

PD: Both! Ultimately the dance moves and the acting have to be received by the people and they should like what they see. So, it's important to get both right and that means putting a lot of effort into it.

#### GC: YOU HAD THIS INTERESTING VENTURE KARUPU RAJA VELAI RAJA WITH VISHAL AND KARTHI. IN THE PIPELINE. RUMOUR HAS IT THAT THE MOVIE HAS STOPPED. IS IT TRUE?

PD: It's a valid question, but I don't quite have the answer! What you know about the movie's progress, is all that even I know. It sure does seem like it is on hold right now!

#### GC: THAT'S A PITY! KARTHI AND VISHAL HAD PROMISED TO GIVE THEIR SALARY TOWARDS THE RECONSTRUCTION OF THE NADIGAR SANGAM BUILDING...

PD: Yeah. It was a good project. Even we found it very interesting. We did talk about it at length and now it has come to a standstill. Why? I have no clue! Maybe everyone has gotten busy and they don't have time for this one. Or maybe it was so good that jealous people cast an evil eye on our dream!

#### GC: YOUR RUMOURED 'LOVE-LIFE' IS AS INTERESTING AS YOUR MOVIES. WHAT'S THE STATUS ON YOUR **RELATIONSHIP WITH TAMANNAAH?**

PD: I have no idea why and how I get linked up with the heroines I work with. It just happens and I ignore it. I

don't feel a thing. However, I do feel bad for the actress. Tamannaah is a wonderful person. She is extremely hardworking. I was in absolute awe watching the dedication and commitment with which she practiced her dance moves. It's really not fair to her.

#### GC: HOW FAR IN THE PAST IS YOUR WHIRLWIND ROMANCE WITH NAYANTARA?

PD: Very far! It happened so many years go. I think even the people have forgotten about it and will be bored to rake it up.

#### GC: NAYANTARA HAS DEFINITELY MOVED ON. WHAT ABOUT YOU? CAN YOU WORK WITH HER IF THE NEED ARISES?

PD: It's great that she has moved on. So have I. My focus is on my work. I've kept myself busy and I've not really thought about what did or did not happen. As for working with her, I don't know what the right answer is! And I'm going to leave it at that.

#### GC: HAVE YOU EVER THOUGHT ABOUT GETTING MARRIED AGAIN? FALLING IN LOVE AGAIN? OR HAVE YOU HAD **ENOUGH OF ALL THAT?**

PD: Honestly, I have not thought about all those things! I am just enjoying my work. Great things are happening here and I'm going with the flow. It's not like I have been through so much trauma in my love-life that I have vowed never to marry or love another woman. I have not had the time or need to think on those lines.

#### GC: WHAT KIND OF A DAD ARE YOU? HOW DO YOU SPEND TIME WITH YOUR BOYS?

PD: I love my sons to bits. I spend as much time as I can with them. I take them on holidays abroad. I drive them to school whenever possible. They are very important to me and I make sure I have quality time with them. I am not concerned

with how much marks they score in their exams. All I want is for them to grow up into decent, respectable men and to be good boys.

## GC: TELL US ABOUT YOUR PARENTS. HOW HAVE THEY SUPPORTED YOU THROUGH EVERY PHASE OF YOUR LIFE?

PD: It is the same with me as with anyone. Without parents' support it is next to impossible to achieve anything. My parents have always been my strength! I love them, but I must add that till today I am thoroughly scared of my father! I fear what he would say about something that I have done. He has scolded me on several occasions for the kinds of movies I have acted in or that I have directed. We don't get into the details of cinema, but he has chided me for some of my movies!

### GC: IS IT HARDER TO TAKE CRITICISM FROM YOUR DAD OR FROM A THIRD PERSON?

**PD:** Criticism from anyone is hard to take. We put in lot of effort to do what we do, so when someone comes along and points out the flaws and puts down the movie, it definitely is a blow. But you have to jump back into the game. I make note of the mistakes I made and try and correct it all the next time. But most often, again critics will have something to say, and I will be left clueless! But I just keep doing what I do and hope to get it right the next time!

And on that positive note, we bid adieu and let him get on with the plans for his next Bollywood flick with Sooraj Pancholi. It took some effort to get him to talk, but it was all worth it in the end! And we wish this elusive super star tonnes of success in the years to come.

#### WHO LET THE LEAKS OUT?




#### HITCHED!

#### A PRINCESS IS BORN


When it was announced that Bigg Boss was to finally get




#### 2 POINT OMG!



GC: What is your take on Vijay's entry into politics?




## GC: Amongst Rajini, Kamal & Vijay, whom do you think should enter politics first?

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




# ADITYA PANCHOLI TELLS HIS SIDE OF THE STORY



#### THE PLOT:



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
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

They say that cinema is largely a reflection of reality, with a smattering of fiction. Which means that more often than not, what we see on screen is what happens in real time, in a small or big way.

If you see a brash and aggressive politician - that sort actually exists. If you see a corrupt cop or govt. official - that lot actually lives amongst us. If you see cruel and criminal doctors, lawyers, engineers and businesspersons, those types of citizens actually live amongst us. If you see casteist, corner-shaving, lawbreaking, wife-beating, petty-thieving citizens, we are these very people in our own communities.

It's a sad irony that while such people do exist and then raise their voices in protest when shown in poor light, the characters that are truly rare to find are the heroes portrayed on-screen - larger than life, fighting battles against armies of bad guys and winning and finally, proving that good does triumph over evil... ironically, not something that happens in real life every time.

What I am trying to say is that while we show indignance toward the powers that be that try to suppress creative voices and works in cinema, how different are we ordinary citizens ourselves? Look at the Padmavati issue! Child marriages and rapes are an everyday reality in this land and yet entire villages are offended at some cinematic representation of a long-ago story?! Holding the livelihoods of thousands of workers in the cinema industry at ransom is infuriating and just plain wrong.

Doctors and lawyers going on strikes because some movie has shown them in a bad light - how about they clean up their own community? Cops protesting unfair portrayal of their fraternity - who can come forward and confidently say that they are incorruptible?

Even the media is no better than any of them, with an opportunistic attitude towards information - instead of sensible, fact-based and dignified reporting, news today has become a medly of sensationalism, half-truths and TRP-greedy stories. Gone are the days when the media was the voice of the common man, the courageous and truth-speaking entity that stands above wrongdoing and quarrelmongering.

Oops, sorry, I couldn't see any difference in the shouting matches and abuse-hurling sessions of panel discussions on news channels and parliament sessions with violent and aggressive people parading as political ambassadors of their people.

All of us with one eye shut are just making hay while the sun shines and in India, the sun shines bright and yellow and mottled all year long. Perhaps it's time to look inward and clean up our mess; and remember to live and let live.

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
