CLOSE TO TEARS?



The concept of transforming a room (usually one that's associated with a bad experience) to change their life resonates with Pete, who lost his 54-year-old brother, Andrew, to cancer in 2012.

We had Andrew at home with us and, after he died, I couldn't go into that room. I was devastated. We had to change the furniture, the layout, everything for me to walk back in there. So I get a bit emotional on the show, because I understand.

Peter admits his current enthusiasm is a world apart from how he felt just over a year ago, revealing he almost gave up his career to be a stay-at-home dad.

When Emily was pregnant with Theo, I thought, "I'm happy to stay at home. I'm content," but I feel hungry again,' he says.

'Now I want to do it for the family. In my 20s, I worked for me, so I could party and have fun. That time is just a blur. I didn't grow up until I had children, and I literally went from a kid to an adult overnight.'

'EMILY'S THE STRICT ONE'

After admitting he would have moved back to Australia if he hadn't had children when he did, Peter now says his happiest times are at home, surrounded by his kids.

Saturdays are my favourite. I'm the pancake king. I've got Theo in the sling – not when I'm cooking! – and Amelia is dancing around. I love having the kids around me. If the kids ask to go to a sleepover, I tell them to bring their friends here. Emily thinks I'm mad!' he laughs.

'For date nights, Emily and I love having people for dinner. Our friends stay over.'

Joking that he and Emily have parenting 'down pat', Peter says he's happy to play 'good cop' to their children, although admits he's a stickler for manners.

'Emily is the strict one. I used to be very strict but I think they're softening me up. They know where the line is, though – it's all about respecting other people. I always make them say please and thank you. The other day, Amelia said, "I'm sorry, Daddy, I don't know why I keep forgetting my pleases and thank-yous." She's only four!

atie Price has made her living and name from her looks. bursting on to the scene as one of the country's top glamour models in the 90s.

Now she's approaching 40 and, as she faces this milestone, it's having a huge effect on the mum and businesswoman.

At last week's National Television Awards, Katie, 39, paraded on the red carpet, posing up a storm for the waiting photographers, while the other women her age were far more demure.

The brash, loud mum-of-five clearly has no intention of quietening down as she approaches her fifth decade, but the upcoming birthday, on May 22, is causing her a lot of anxiety.

Kieran has cheated on her several times, most recently with their nanny. Nikki Brown. While Katie has vowed to divorce him, he is still living in their family home with Katie and her other kids, Harvey, 15, Junior, 12, and Princess, 10.

Now, Katie is so unsure what to do that's she has turned to a psychic for help.

Yet, friends of Rihanna and Hassan are hopeful they can overcome any differences in their backgrounds. 'It's very different to Janet Jackson's situation,' says a source. 'Janet's estranged husband is Qatari, but basically grew up in London. Rihanna has a much healthier balance in her relationship.

The fact is, Hassan has a very liberal interpretation of what's permitted as a Muslim. So the idea is that Rihanna will publicly make some concessions to Islam, and talk glowingly about the faith, but she's not going to convert completely like Janet Jackson."

'He has the sort of wealth and standing that make for real solidity – Rihanna feels totally safe in his arms, and that's a rarity in her life these days,' adds the source.

While RiRi comes from Barbados, and is well known for her provocative song lyrics and sexy dance moves, Hassan hails from a strict Muslim country - something many thought would come between them.

Yet, Hassan has been completely accepting of Rihanna and her past, and is keen to marry her, and show the world the modern side to Saudi Arabia.

'It's just amazing to her that a man from such a conservative country could be so accepting of the way she lives her life,' says the insider. 'Rihanna genuinely believes that this is true love, and there is talk that they could marry before the year is out.

Saudi Arabia is opening up to the world, and its ruler, Mohammed Bin Salman, believes that having Rihanna onboard could help re-launch his country.

Rihanna and Hassan have been dating for just over a year, after the tycoon flew a life-sized teddy bear half way around

the world in an otherwise empty jet just to impress her.

It has taken the Umbrella singer a long time to find true love - after illfated romances with Chris Brown and Drake, among others - and friends say she's certain Hassan is marriage material.

'Rihanna was sick of bad boyfriends but, when Hassan came along, something really changed,' continues the source.

'It was the first time she was looking at a man not just as

a boyfriend, but as a husband and future father of her child.'

Hassan - whose family were ranked No.12 on Forbes Middle East's list of the world's richest Arab families in 2016 with a staggering net worth of £1.5 billion - has been married once before, to Tunisian art expert Lina Lazaar.



'Discussing exercise and reading on your dating profile gets both sexes 21 per cent more messages, while talking about music gets

15 per cent more,' explains Kate.

'Exercise obviously scores well, as it implies you're fit and in good shape – both sexy qualities. I'd imagine "reading" is a word that attracts women more than men.

'I once read research that said we should use words that are usually associated with the opposite sex. For example, a woman mentioning video games on her profile would get a lot of responses, but for men it wouldn't.

'But when a man mentions family and kids on his profile, he gets more attention than women who use those words.

'Music is also good because it gives you an opening line. It's a good way to suggest date ideas, such as concerts and festivals. For example, you could open up with, "I hear you're into Ed Sheeran, did you like his new album?"

'When it comes to using flirty words, referring to a man as "baby" or "beautiful" will see a woman's response rate rocket by 118 per cent, and 50 per cent respectively. But men who do the same get 10 per cent and 13 per cent fewer replies.

'That's easy to understand, as women as a whole don't like fake attraction. To us, being called "baby" or "beautiful" by a man who has never met us in real life is clearly fake, and suggests he's going around the internet or dating sites chatting people up indiscriminately,' continues Kate.

'It's also a bit sleazy. Some men have gone totally wild online, sharing naked photos and sexting strangers, so you can't blame females for being wary!

'Men have none of those qualms. But I would say that those who are looking for long-term serious relationships have been proven to prefer women who are more reticent with their flirting. So if you want a fling, call men "baby" – but if you want a husband, save the sweet-talk till the second date.'

Our family sugar detox

According to Public Health England, the average child eats three times more sugar than they should. But how easy is it to get your kids to ditch the sweet stuff? Reveal's Rebecca Gamble puts her two sons through the sugar-free test

onsuming too much sugar puts your children at risk of obesity, tooth decay and a whole host of other conditions. With that in mind. our Mum's The Word columnist, Rebecca Gamble, decided to use The Sugar Free Family Cookbook to whizz up some meals for her boys, Fergus, five, and Rafferty, two, for a week.

'They both have issues with sugar. Fergus's behaviour and mood alters a lot, while Rafferty has a very sweet tooth and would gorge on sweet foods if I let him,' says Rebecca. 'So I was keen to see if this diet would make a difference.'

Before starting the sugarfree week, Rebecca made a meal plan for the seven days, including snacks. 'I couldn't get all the ingredients I needed in one supermarket, so I had to make a few different trips,' she says. 'I spent a lot of time cooking, but I could make big batches and freeze the food.'

Rebecca didn't tell her kids they were going sugar-free as she didn't want them to think they were missing out.

Tjust raved about the new dishes we were going to try together,' she explains.

I was pleasantly surprised by their reactions. When I made some dark chocolate coconut bars - unsweetened desiccated coconut mixed with coconut cream and oil - I thought they'd find them too rich or bitter, but they enjoyed them.

'And they didn't get hyper afterwards, like they would have done after a chocolate bar.

'There were some meals neither of them liked, though - in particular, the sugar-free berry jelly. Fergus said he "didn't like all the bits in it", explains Rebecca.

But when I fed them a healthy chicken Kiev, using homemade garlic butter with the chicken coated in polenta and herbs, they both loved it."

Rebecca had a similar response with fish fingers coated in a polenta mix. 'I'd given up making my own fish fingers, as it can get messy with the breadcrumbs, but polenta is so much easier,' she says.

So were there any downsides to going sugar-free? 'It wasn't all plain sailing - I regretted making buttermilk pancakes on a rushed school morning!' recalls Rebecca. 'Thankfully, there were lots of quick breakfast options like porridge with berries or scrambled eggs.

'But, I must admit, I did miss

the convenience of opening a jar of pasta sauce for a quick lunch,' she adds. 'And it was a little more expensive, too. Some ingredients were pricey - the cheapest coconut oil was £3.74,' says Rebecca. 'However, it was still cheaper cooking from scratch. I also found the same ingredients popped up in lots of recipes.'

The benefits of eating sugarfree were obvious, though.

'I was pleased with how well both boys embraced it,' she says. 'They were very calm and well-behaved all week. It definitely made a difference. While it's been hard work, I'll continue to use the recipes and follow the principles."

TV's DR PHIL HAMMOND answers your questions and gives it to you straight on the big health issues

I'M A DOCTOR

SPICY SOLUTION

I've been reading a lot about the health benefits of turmeric. How much do you have to eat, and is it worth it?

Naomi, Brockham

Turmeric is a yellowy-orange spice that's very popular in south Asian cooking. It contains a compound called curcumin, which has powerful antioxidant and anti-inflammatory properties. It can stop the growth of bad bacteria, parasites and fungi and protects the intestinal wall. Some people believe it reduces your risk of chronic diseases and cancer, but more studies are needed. You could take a teaspoon a day. Add it to food such as soup or yoghurt, or stir it into warm milk. More turmeric is absorbed if you add pepper or chillies.

CANCEROUS CONCERNS

If you pluck hairs from moles will it give you cancer?

Toyah, Norwich

No. Plucking hairs from your moles, squeezing them with tweezers or cutting them while shaving will not make them cancerous. However, any mole that appears where there wasn't one before, or that changes its appearance, should be checked by a doctor. Signs of cancer include part of the mole looking different from the other parts, bleeding not caused by plucking or shaving, an irregular border, an uneven colour and an increase in size beyond 6mm.

HOW CAN I USE MY SMARTPHONE TO IMPROVE MY HEALTH? Charlie, Glasgow

Most smartphones have apps that will measure your physical activity, such as the number of steps you do. Wearable devices can also help you with your sleep patterns and monitor your pulse and blood pressure. For some people, this can help them stay healthy, for others it makes them more anxious. 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






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








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INGREDIENTS

100g raw king prawns 2 medium leeks, shredded 150g smoked haddock fillet 150g cod fillet 150g salmon fillet, all boned and skinned 500ml semi-skimmed milk 1tsp Dijon mustard 1tbsp cornflour Salt and pepper
Zest of 1 lemon
1tbsp chopped parsley
1tbsp chopped dill fronds
1 sweet potato, peeled
150g cauliflower,
cut into florets
Olive oil
2tbsp grated Parmesan

Serves 4

MFTHOD

→ Preheat the oven to 200°C. Make a shallow cut down the centre of each prawn, pull out the black vein, then rinse the prawn thoroughly.

→ Put the leeks in a frying pan with a lid and add 1tbsp water. Cover and steam-fry for 5 mins. Add the prawns, fish, milk and mustard to the pan, return to the boil, then reduce the heat.

Cover and simmer for 5 mins until the fish is opaque. Drain and reserve the liquid. Then remove the prawns, fish and leeks. Put them into an ovenproof dish.

Mix the cornflour with a little water to form a smooth paste. Stir into the hot milk liquid. Heat it gently, stirring well for 2 mins, or until the milk thickens. Season and add lemon zest. Stir in the herbs, then pour over the fish and leeks.

→ Put the sweet potato into a large saucepan of boiling water and add the cauliflower florets. Blanch for 2 mins. Remove from the pan, cool, then grate the potato and cauliflower into a large, clean dish towel. Squeeze gently to remove the excess liquid. Tip the mixture into a bowl.

Add the oil and Parmesan, and season. Scatter the mixture over the fish. Bake for 25-30 mins until the top is golden brown, and the filling is bubbling hot.
